NOVEL CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19

May 27, 2020;

The Health Officer of Anderson County has previously recommended that businesses with buffets/self-service food stations and businesses with self-service beverage stations open with restrictions. At this point, the Health Officer is recommending these businesses open their buffets/stations without restrictions to customers. However, good hygiene practices, social distancing guidelines, mass gathering guidelines, and good cleaning practices should continue to be implemented by businesses.

The Local Health Officer urges the public to continue to take appropriate actions, by taking responsibility for themselves and their loved ones. **EVERYONE** should continue to practice social distancing, clean/disinfect any highly touched surfaces, wash your hands with soap and water routinely, use hand sanitizer if soap and water is not available, stay home if sick and **avoid touching your face** (especially eyes, nose & mouth).

Close contact means: 6 foot or less for 10 minutes or more, with a positive case.
