

Providing trauma-focused outpatient treatment

Sliding Scale Criteria (Full License – LPC, LSCSW, LCSW):

- 1. No health insurance coverage for mental health outpatient services.
- 2. Medicare (LPCs only).
- 3. Any insurance which will not pay mental health/out-of-network benefits.
- 4. Income (from employment, disability, or otherwise) below \$30,000 per year.
- 5. Within the last 6 months, discharged from an in-patient psychiatric hospitalization or long-term medical care.
- 6. Unemployed for at least 6 months or have never been employed.
- 7. Currently on some form of public assistance or social security/disability.
- 8. A single mother or father.
- 9. A full time student.

Sliding Scale Criteria (Provisional License – PLPC, LMSW):

- 1. Income (from employment, disability, or otherwise) below \$30,000 per year.
- 2. Within the last 6 months, discharged from an in-patient psychiatric hospitalization or long-term medical care.
- 3. Unemployed for at least 6 months or have never been employed.
- 4. Currently on some form of public assistance or social security/disability.
- 5. A single mother or father.
- 6. A full time student.
- 7. No health insurance coverage for mental health outpatient services or health insurance coverage for mental health but unable to file a claim for reimbursement due to provider having provisional license (which most insurance will not reimburse for).

If qualified, the sliding scale fee will be determined prior to or during your initial assessment and will be based upon the criteria met above. Should your financial situation change, your fee will be reassessed and it is your responsibility to notify us of any changes.
