Location: The museum is a 33 minute, 21.4 mile drive from Chapter Event site via Van Buren Blvd.

Carl Morrison will lead this Photo Walk and be available for photo location questions. Participants can go to the varied locations on-their-own. This Photo Walk does NOT require an indemnity form. It is an independent photographic activity.

Since the locomotives and other rolling stock are so large and sometimes you cannot get very far back from them, I used a 10-20 wide angle zoom for the photos in this essay:

If you want to connect with Carl about 9:30, he will be near the steam engine on his electric scooter.

Orientation and Shoot: Explore the West's largest collection of railway locomotives, passenger and freight cars, streetcars, interurban electric cars, buildings and other artifacts dating from the 1870's.

Access to the grounds and buildings is free. An all-day pass to ride the trains costs \$12. Most of the display buildings will be open. Trolleys and trains operate 11 AM to 5 PM. The grounds are quite large and contain many buildings, parks, and outdoor areas to explore. Dress appropriately for the weather and wear comfortable walking shoes—there's a lot to see.

Disability Notes: Since Carl cannot walk very far nor stand for very long, he will take his electric scooter, but he realizes the age of most of the rolling transportation was before ADA standards. Since he can transfer, he will leave his scooter at the platform when he rides any of the trolleys or the steam train coaches.

Date: Sunday, March 17, 2019 **Hours:** 9 am to 5 pm

Meet: Carl will be there to photograph the **Steam Engine No. 2** as it comes out for the day. Park and enter the museum grounds right at opening, 9 am. The place to see the locomotive at opening is between the platform (23 on the map) and Town Hall (11 on the map).

Cost: Parking and admission is free. An all-day pass to ride the trains and trolleys costs \$12.
