**MICHIGAN EQUINE LIABILITY ACT**  
1994 Public Act No. 351

It is a condition of entry to these shows and the show grounds of Twin Elm Training in Northville, MI, that every competitor, owner, handler, trainer, and parent agree to assume the risk of showing at the Opportunity Series under the Michigan Equine Liability Act. By submitting an entry, a competitor further agrees that they, the owner, handler trainer, parent and anyone associated with exhibiting a horse at the show waives all claims against the show, show management, its employees, the facility, its owners, and employees for any injury to themselves attendants or horses/ponies.

<b>RIDE FEES</b>	\$30.00 per test. \$30 office fee. The \$30.00 office fee applies to each horse/rider combination.
<b>STABLING</b>	Stalls are \$70.00 per weekend. Stabling may be in the main barn or shed row barn. Shavings available for purchase at \$10.00 per bag. <b>NO HAY OR GRAIN AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.</b> Stalls will be available at 1PM on the Friday prior to the show. All horses showing from trailers will be charged a \$35/horse haul in fee. Non Showing horses are \$35 per show additional to haul in or stall fee.
<b>REFUNDS</b>	<b>There will be NO refunds for any reason after the closing date.</b> Before closing date, full refunds minus the \$30 office fee.
<b>DOGS</b>	No dogs allowed
<b>AWARDS</b>	Ribbons 1 <sup>st</sup> -6 <sup>th</sup> place: Champion and Reserve determined by the highest percentage for each division with at least 3 entries (divisions and levels may be combined if there are less than 3 entries). Year-end awards are determined by averaging the 2 highest test scores (from 2 different shows) from each horse/rider combo who attended at least 2 shows.
<b>DRESSAGE TESTS</b>	The 2023 USEF/ USDF dressage tests, 2022 USEF Eventing tests, and 2022 Western Dressage Tests will be used. All tests may be read. Horse/Rider combinations may show in only 2 consecutive levels. Example: Intro and Training level or Training and First level, etc.
<b>COMBINING/ SPLITTING OF TESTS</b>	Tests will be combined if there are less than 3 entries. Tests will be split if there are more than 12 entries or at management's discretion. If you do not indicate your level on your entry form you will automatically be entered as OPEN.
<b>WDAA</b>	All shows are approved by WDAA. If you would like your points to count toward WDAA awards, you must be a member prior to the show and include your number on the entry blank
<b>WDAMI</b>	Must be a member of both WDAMI and WDAA prior to the start of the show to be eligible for year end awards.
<b>MDA</b>	All shows are approved by the Midwest Dressage Association. If you wish for your points to count toward MDA year end awards, you must join MDA prior to the show and include your MDA number on your entry blank.

- NOVICE** Novice rider- any rider in their 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing dressage at any venue. Novice horse- any horse in its 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing with any rider at any venue. Winning 3 blue ribbons will automatically make the rider/horse ineligible for this division the following year.
- JUNIOR** A rider who was less than 18 on December 1, 2025.
- HEADGEAR** DR 120.6. From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted
- WESTERN ATTIRE** Riders may compete in a long sleeve shirt with any type of collar, with trousers or pants, or a one piece long sleeved equitation suit provided it includes a collar. Suitable western hats are accepted, and protective headgear may be worn without penalty. Please refer to WD123 for more information on required and optional apparel.
- ATTIRE** Riders may compete wearing breeches and shirts of any color as permitted in DR120.8. Jackets or vests of any type are allowed but not required and neckwear may be worn only if the rider chooses to compete in a riding jacket. Boots and protective headgear are required as specified in DR120.1-6.
- RIDE TIMES** **Ride times will be available by 10 AM the Thursday prior to the show.** Ride time requests will only be honored if they do not disadvantage other riders. After ride times are posted, any open times due to scratches will be posted in the show office. Times will be posted on [twinelmtraining.com](http://twinelmtraining.com) and emailed to riders if a legible email is provided. - SCHOOLING** The ring will be open for schooling on Friday after 1 pm weather permitting. Please check for any signage near the ring. The ring will not be open the morning of the show. All lunging should be done in the schooling ring by the barns.

## TWIN ELM TRAINING'S OPPORTUNITY SERIES

Classes may be combined or divided based on the number of entries received. Please be sure to indicate your rider status on your entry form so that you are placed in the correct division. Tests with at least 3 riders per division (JR, AM or Open) will be divided. Tests with less than 3 riders may be combined at management's discretion. See rules above for further info.

## Twin Elm Training Entry Agreement 2026

Every entry at this competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, rider and the horse:

1. Failure to comply with any of the health and safety requirements or newly implemented procedures may result in removal from the grounds. Refunds will not be issued in cases of noncompliance.
2. That the owner, rider, trainer, coach and any of their agents acknowledge that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk of injury or loss and they agree to hold the competition and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered, resulted, directly or indirectly, from negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the competition.”

Acknowledges that if damages shall be occasioned or loss occur, by any means, to the horses exhibited, or to any vehicle or other article that may be sent with such horse(s), that no claim will be made therefore, and further agree to hold the TWIN ELM TRAINING, owners of the grounds, officials, members or employees harmless from any claim or demand of whatsoever kind or nature, that may be occasioned by the horse(s), and to repay to this show on demand, all damages it may sustain by reason of any claim or demand as aforesaid.
