WHAT ARE CRYSTAL FORMS

- Add-On to P21
- Crystal Reports that facilitate printing documents onside of P21 such as the Order Acknowledgement, Invoice and PO
- Successor to Adobe Forms (Jetforms)



THINGS TO KNOW

- Script from Epicor enables this feature
- Modified filenames need to have "_user" at end of the filename. Ex: invoice_user.rpt;invoice_user.xsd
- Files to modify are gotten from Epicor download website
- Xsd files are modified with Custom Data Streams



SYSTEM SETTINGS

- Forms Customization Enabled -> System Settings -> Printing
- Output File Backup Option found in P21 -> System Settings -> Printing
- Files get saved in the report path found in P21 -> System Settings -> Files and Folders



MODIFY THE FORMS

- Forms are Modified through a program named Crystal Reports
- Most new versions of crystal reports will work



COMMON CHANGES TO FORMS

- Adding/removing/moving fields
- Change font sizes
- Add logos
- Add barcodes



DEPLOY THE FORMS

- Copy or save the rpt and xsd files to the correct path in based on your system settings
- It is sometimes a good idea to save the files in a different folder that your play database points to.
- New versions are effective as soon as they are saved to the proper folder.
