MINUTES

HOLYOAK: There has been no response to the letter Dale wrote to the Ray Holyoak Estate. Consensus of the Board is to stay HOLYOAK with the terms of the letter and be prepared to shut the water off July 1, 1995.

ESTATE

River Water Policy: After discussion was held the Board voted on a motion to set River Water Rates at \$15.00 per acre foot using the existing contract with appropriate modifications. The lease will be on a year-to-year basis and will be re-evaluated in approximately 6 months. Motion: Bobbie Second: White MOTION CARRIED. Gary suggested that Dale call people who will be effected and let them know that the Board has set their rate at \$15.00 per acre foot, and that they will have to sign an agreement. The agreement will be presented to the Board after modification.

RIVER WATER POLICY

Industrial Water Rates: There is a need for the Board to set industrial water rates. Example: LeGrand Johnson is purchasing industrial water at the rate of \$23.00, and the Golf Course purchases water at the rate of \$35.00. Dale suggested to the Board that it will be necessary to revise our agreement to state that people cannot convert agricultural water to municipal industrial water without reassigning it through the district. Jim Walker: Moab Irrigation requires that users come in and tell them where and for what the water will be used, how much, and where it is going to be delivered and this district might want to set that same requirement.

INDUSTRIAL WATER RATES Check Approval: Motion: Bobbie Second: Groo MOTION CARRIED
