# Wednesday Night Lenten Program - begins 2/21

Join us on Wednesday evenings this Lent for a potluck soup and salad supper, followed by a program and discussion. On February 21 and March 21, we'll be looking more deeply at some of the scriptures of Lent. On February 28, March 7, and March 14, we'll be joined by local therapist/counselor, Sue Panger, who will be talking about False Guilt (see below for more information). The supper

False Guilt: On three consecutive Wednesdays, February 28th, March 7th, and March 14th, Sue Panger will be presenting on the topic of False Guilt. As Lent is a time when we look inward to discern where we have sinned and to repent for these sins, Sue will encourage a different self examination. What is False Guilt? Do we as Christians perhaps carry unnecessary burdens by feeling guilty when we have done nothing wrong? With active participation, small group discussions, and a look into Scripture, Sue will invite you to look at how we are raised as Christians to feel guilt as a state of being rather than a careful journey toward personal responsibility and growth. The discussions will begin at 7 pm with a light supper preceding at 6:30.
