Program Updates

Haircuts from the Heart remains on hiatus due to the stylist being unavailable due to a family emergency. The position is posted but has not yielded any viable candidates.

Tamar's Center has provided clients information about our new location and many have expressed excitement about the area and a desire to continue to receive services in Lower Price Hill. We have also done several outreach events and are beginning to see new clients. The numbers are increasing and if they stay the course, we will need to revisit hiring a Peer Support Specialist to augment the case manager's responsibilities and allow the case manager to conduct groups, develop strategies to implement trauma sensitive programming, and provide quasi counseling. We have some building improvements pending and then the facility will be finished.

Tau House- The first group of the summer arrived 6/12/22 and the schedule for the remainder of the season is full.

Community Garden- The garden is coming alive with many plots already producing.

Our annual event, "Bubbles and Brew" is scheduled for September at Centennial Barn. The activities will include food, drink, music and an auction. A Development Committee headed by Grace Marie has started meeting and planning.
