40th ANNIVERSARY TRAIN CARS!

We have a special box car that has been painted and decorated by Javen Schmucker for our 40th Anniversary celebration in 2025. We have 26 O-gauge cars and 16 S-Gauge cars. These are the last of the stock we bought from TTOS a few years back. Thank you Javen for your hard work!

The cost of the cars will be \$65 (plus tax) for each car, with *no member discount*. Due to the small number of cars, we must limit purchases to one car of each Gauge (total of two) per household.

The cars will be available for Pre-ordering beginning October 2024. *Cars must be paid for at the time of pre-ordering*. The exact date for handing out the cars has not been established, but will be at an event in 2025. See the Yard-Master, beginning in October, to order yours!!!

Thanks to a donation of funds, we now have a folding stairway to access the area behind the new train display. This is a much safer way to access this area not only to work on the display but for storage as well.

The stairway is located by the pop machine with the cord on a hook on the wall to keep it out of the way and curious hands to try to pull down the stairs. On the upstairs level, there is a guard rail to prevent anyone working

up there to accidentally step into the opening.

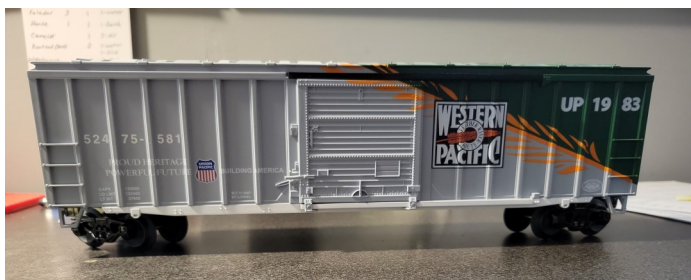
