

ORDINANCE NO. 27.

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION ON MAY 4, 1991 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING CITY OFFICIALS FOR THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LOG CABIN CITY COUNCIL:

SECTION I.

An election is hereby ordered to be held in the City of Log Cabin, Texas on May 4, 1991 same being the First Saturday in May, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. Election to be held at City Hall for the purpose of electing the following officials: Two (2) Councilpersons for terms of two (2) years and a Mayor for a term of Two (2) years.

SECTION II.

That Tonie Algor is hereby appointed presiding Judge of the election and Susan Turner is appointed alternate Judge. The presiding election Judge is granted authority to appoint as many election clerks as deemed necessary to properly conduct said election without prior or subsequent approval or ratification by the City Council of the City of Log Cabin, Texas.

SECTION III.

That the official ballot of said election of May 4, 1991 shall substantially comply with the laws of the State of Texas governing municipal elections.

SECTION IV.

That only qualified voters residing in the City of Log Cabin, Texas shall be eligible to vote at said election.

SECTION V.

That Norma J. Menillo is hereby appointed clerk for absentee voting. The absentee voting shall be held at 1462 Travis Lane, Log Cabin, Texas. Absentee voting shall be 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. each day with the exception of Saturdays, Sundays, and official State Holidays. Absentee voting shall begin at 9:00 A.M. on April 15, 1991 and end at 5:00 P.M. on April 30, 1991.

SECTION VI.

That notice of said election shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation, published in Henderson County. Said publication shall not be less than ten (10) nor more than thirty (30) days before the election. The Mayor is hereby instructed to cause such notice to be given.
