We always appreciate your input, feel free to message us on social media or email. Looking forward to seeing you at the park and in May for the clean up day. Take care and have fun! See you at the park!


Here are the ideas for the park renovations this fall: (hopefully we can pull this off by Halloween)

**This one might take some visualisation. We would like to put this at the bottom of the existing rail, going of the park. So it would start at the corner of the existing bank and go out into the grass. This would give you speed for the new BUMP TO BAR that would replace the existing square one. This would be round and the appropriate height and length.**


**replace existing "bump to bar" with a better one. Then add this return in the grass after the landing.**




**Adding a chip or loveseat feature to the middle of the 6 foot. This would be about 6 feet wide and 2 feet lower than the coping. This would have a regular radius just a little tighter than the existing quarter pipe.**



**Changing the steep jump to jumps to mellow banks that would make the ledges more skateable and give an easier gap to skate for flip tricks etc..**




**Changing the ledge that is right in the middle of the park by  
-making it level and new angle iron like other new ledge  
bringing the edge out so you don't land in the curved roller.**




**You're looking at the ledge at the front of the park that everyone
