General Meeting Minutes

October 13, 2022

Secretary's Report: Minutes from the September 2022 meeting was read by Mike Wyckoff. Motion was made and minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Cal Roberts provided the Treasurer's Report showing a savings balance of \$124,969.03 and a checking balance of \$8,490.52. Treasurer's Report was approved.

Membership Report: Mike Wyckoff provided a membership report: 9 Board of Directors, 21 Reduced Rate Members and 303 Social Members for a total of 333 out of the 350 limit. We also have 30 Life Members, 4 Honorary and 7 Jr. for an additional 41 with total of 374.

Mike Wyckoff had 3 new applications for membership. John Brewer, John Powers and Dan Hanolt received final approval from the membership and were welcomed as new members by the President.

Mike Sabat reported that Smallbore shooting will be starting on October 19<sup>th</sup>. Regular shooting days will be on Wednesdays. Anyone wanting to join should contact Mike Sabat or Greg Paff.

Dan Charles reported that Youth Shooting will be starting this Saturday October 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM. He requests as many RSOs as possible help with this activity. Youth Shooting will be on the first and third Saturdays of the month.

Dan Grey reported that Youth Archery would be starting in December. He has obtained smaller weight bows so all age groups will be able to participate.

County League Rep, Vic Gurinowitsch, reminded members that County League meeting minutes are available on the County League website.

A bid was accepted by the Board to purchase a Pavilion. Construction should be completed in November.

Work Day items:

- 1) Prep work so electric can be run from the Archery building to the Pavilion.
- 2) Cut weeds along creek to improve sight lines on the 200 yard range.
- 3) Split fire wood to be stored in the bridge.
- 4) Replace screws in roof that have deteriorated.
- 5) Install light for parking lot.
