In areas with significant hardwood regeneration, avoid damage to saplings, especially yellow birch. Utilize pulp to a 4-inch top diameter and saw logs to a 10-inch top diameter. Follow WI BMP's for Water Quality – some low areas may only be accessible during frozen ground or very dry conditions. All pine products must be hauled from the landing within 3 weeks of harvesting from June 15 through August 15. If game openings are used for landings, they must be cleared of all logging debris prior to sale closeout.
