





No harvest activity during April, May, or June. Protect residual stems, seedlings, and saplings from damage and eliminate rutting. Follow all Wisconsin BMPs at all times.

Harvest Specifications: Harvest all trees marked with orange paint, and all balsam. Harvest all aspen greater than 10 inches DBH. Utilize saw timber to a 10" minimum top diameter and pulp to a 4" minimum top diameter. Protect residual stems, seedlings, and saplings, especially elm seedlings and saplings, from damage. Eliminate rutting. Follow all Wisconsin BMPs for soil and water quality at all times. No harvest activity from April to July. New road construction must be approved by Iron County Forest Administrator before operations commence.



Prevent damage to residual stock especially. No cutting in or around existing ephemeral ponds or creeks. Prevent and minimize rutting at all costs. Leave existing snag trees standing. No slash left on or over blue line to the north. Follow all BMP's. No harvesting April to June.


Cut all Aspen, Balam, Spruce and Hardwood containing one or more 100 inch pulpstick to a 4 inch minimum top diameter except that Yellow Birch is not to be cut. Do not cut Hemlock, Cedar or Pine. The snowmobile trail must be kept open at all times. Do not operate machinery within 15 feet of wetland areas except during frozen ground conditions. Eliminate rutting.








<u>Harvest Specifications</u>: Harvest all aspen, red maple, sugar maple, balsam fir, and ironwood with at least one 100 inch stick and harvest all trees marked with an orange slash. In areas with significant hardwood regeneration, avoid damage to saplings, especially yellow birch. Utilize pulp to a 4-inch top diameter and saw logs to a 10-inch top diameter. Follow WI BMP's for Water Quality — some low areas may only be accessible during frozen ground or very dry conditions. All pine products must hauled from the landing within 3 weeks of harvesting from June 15 through August 15. If game openings are used for landings, they must be cleared of all logging debris prior to sale closeout.



Harvest all timber marked with orange paint. Harvest all merchantable ironwood. Utilize saw logs to a 10 inch minimum top diameter, pulpwood to a 4 inch minimum top diameter. Protect quality advanced regeneration, especially Red Oak, Yellow Birch and Elm, from harvest damage. Follow all Wisconsin BMPs for Water Quality. No logging activity from April to July. Snowmobile trail will remain open and useable during all harvest operations.




#### Harvest Specifications Area 1 (80 acres)

Harvest all trees marked with orange paint along with all spruce, balsam fir, and aspen greater than 9 inches in diameter. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Harvest will not take place from April 1st through July 1st. Sale boundaries is solid red line.


### Harvest Specifications Area 2 (77 acres)

Harvest everything 2 inches dbh and up, except for cedar, hemlock, tamarack, and pine. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Sale boundaries is two red dots.



#### Harvest Specifications Area
