

# Sidney Township Cemetery

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## Rules and Regulations

Welcome to Sidney Township Cemetery. The guidelines contained herein are designed for the express purpose of governing the activities in the Cemetery for the mutual protection and benefit of lot holders and the Cemetery as a whole. They are established with certain restrictions to ensure a degree of uniformity and control within the Cemetery grounds to achieve the preservation of Cemetery character and those landscape qualities that contribute to a peaceful and reflective place.

1. This cemetery is open daylight hours only. No horses or recreational vehicles allowed. No loitering at any time.
2. Please drive in designated areas only.
3. Winter decorations and faded floral arrangements will be removed after April 1 or when they become unsightly.
4. No GLASS containers. All trash shall be placed in appropriate trash receptacle or removed from the grounds.
5. All urns, bushes, shrub, or rose bushes and decorations must be placed within the designated 2x4 section of the gravesite. If any bushes, shrub, or rose bushes are planted, owner must keep trimmed and neat.
6. No trees are to be planted. When needed, twp will plant dwarf trees.
7. Existing trees, shrubs, and plants may be trimmed or removed at the discretion of the cemetery authority. The lot owner is responsible for the cost of removing trees, etc. for the purpose of burials on their lot.
8. There shall be no enclosures such as fencing, lattice, landscape timbers, cement, stone, or brick, on or around the lots. Also, no loose stones or gravel are to be placed on the lots. No mounds of dirt or other material shall be built on lots.
9. No benches, structures or arches (wood, iron, plastic, cement, etc.) shall be placed on lots.
10. All burials, including cremations, shall be arranged by the sexton.
11. Winter burials shall be done at the discretion of the cemetery authority.
12. Sale or transfer of lots must be recorded with the Sidney Twp. Clerk.
