Facing East from Chapultepec Castle is the Luciferian truncated iconoclastic unfinished pyramid with the All-Seeing Eye. In this case it is rendered 3-deminsional. This is referred to a the Eye of Horus and of Lucifer, the Shining One, which Quetzalcoatl can also mean as in light. This Meso-American god was purported to be light-skinned that promised to return one day. His symbol was the Cross and was associated with the bright and morning star, Venus. How Osiris is connected to the Feathered Serpent is that Coyolxauhqui, like Osiris, was dismembered in 14 parts, the Queen of Heaven (Virgin of Guadalupe) thus set out to search out for the missing part which is attributed to the phallus. This is why the Masons and other Luciferians venerate the Obelisks and call them the Shaft of Ba'al. The Aztecs like other ancient civilizations incorporated this Atlantean religion before spreading to the trans-Atlantic 'gods' of the Egyptians, etc. As the capital of the Aztecs was an island, the main causeways are now streets as the lakebed has been filled up. The Spaniards, Mason, etc., thereafter configured sacred geometry with certain ley-lines like the Hexagram. Hexagrams are used in the occult to summons demons, spirits and open portals or doors into other dimensions. The principle behind this symbol represents the ancient old mantra of 'As Above, So
