**Approval of Agenda** – December 10, 2025, at 9:00 AM: Commissioner Owens moved to approve the Agenda for December 10, 2025; seconded by Commissioner Shephard; the motion was approved by the Commission.

**PUBLIC HEARING**

Vice Chairman Rainey read the reason for the Public Hearing – Millage Rate. Please see below.

**Millage Rate**

1. **Public Hearing** – The City of Cordele has tentatively adopted a millage rate of 11.060 mills, which is the same rate the city has adopted for the past five (5) years. Without this tentative tax increase of 0.001%, the millage rate would be no more than 11.059 mills.

The proposed tax increase, without a rollback, for a homestead property in the city with a fair market value of \$150,000 is approximately \$0.064 per year, the proposed tax increase, without a rollback, for non-homestead property in the city with a fair market value of \$300,000 is \$1.33.
