

Ordinance Number 658

An Ordinance appropriating certain money's .

Be it ordained by the mayor and Commissioners of the city of Garnett, Kansas,

Section One:- that the sum of Six Hundred and ~~30~~³⁶/100 ----- Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Water Works Extension Bond Interest Fund to pay the Bills allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 17th day of April 1916 a list of which may be found on page 275 of the journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Two:- that the sum of Two Hundred and 25/100----- Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Water Works Extension Bond Interest Fund 1913 to pay the Bills allowed against said Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 17th day of April 1916 a list of which may be found on page 275 of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said Date.

Section Three:- that the sum of Three Hundred and Seventy Five and 47/100----- Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Electric Bond Interest Fund to pay the Bills allowed against said Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 17th day of April 1916 a list of which may be found on page 275 of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Four:- that the sum of ~~Sixty Six and no/100~~ Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund to pay the Bills allowed against said Fund at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 17th day of April 1916 a list of which may be found on page 275 of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on said date.

Section Five:- that the Mayor and city Clerk be and are hereby authorized and instructed to draw warrants on the City Treasurer to pay the Bills allowed in the foregoing sections of this ordinance.

Section Six:- that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners and its approval by the mayor.
