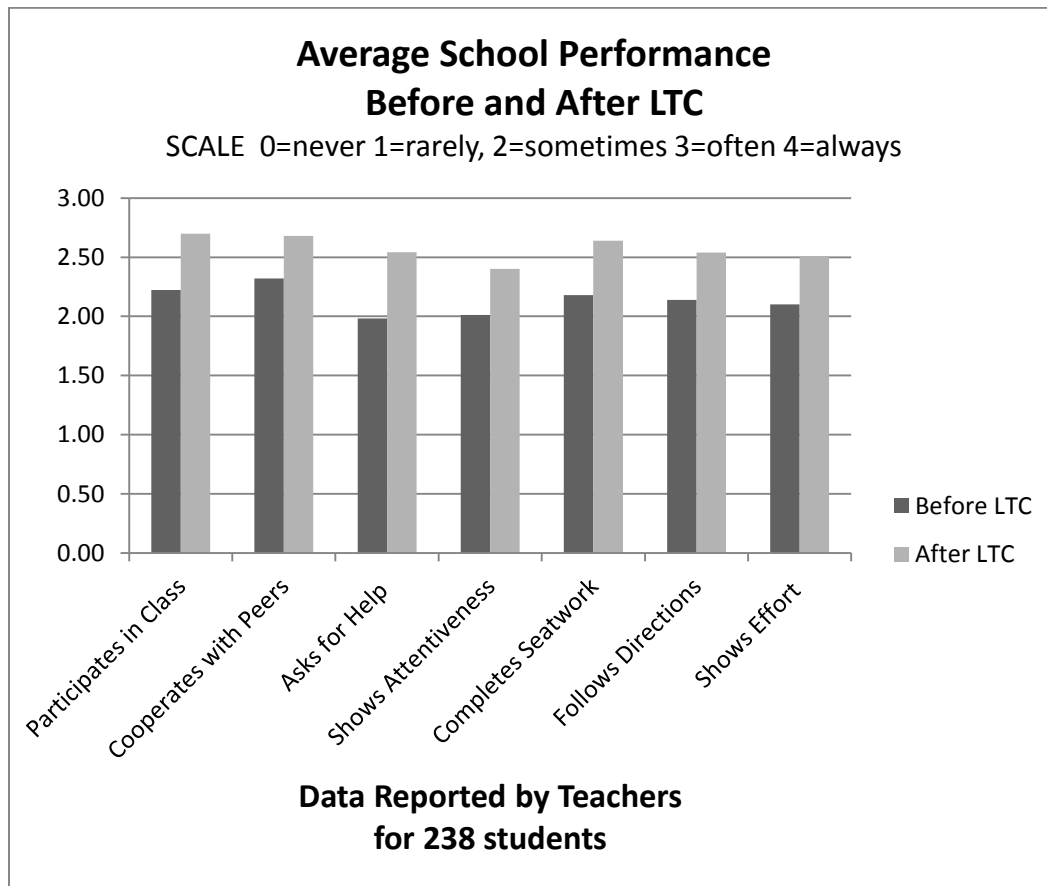




Listen To Children
