Ordinance No 3

an ordinance providing for the meetings of the Board and for other purposes.

be it ordained by the board of Trustees of the Town of Gurnett:

Set 1st that the regular meetings of the board of Trustees of the Town of Gurnett shall be held on the first Tuesday evening of each month at the hour of 7 o'clock at the office now occupied by the register of Deeds of the County of Anderson on ~~7th Avenue~~ Street of the Town of Gurnett

Set 2nd that the Chairman of the board of Trustees shall preside at all meetings of said board when present. but in case of the absence of the Chairman the members present shall choose a Chairman pro tempore who shall preside at such meetings

Set 3rd the ~~Secretary~~ of the board of Trustees shall keep a complete Journal of the proceedings of each meeting of the board to be recorded in a book to be kept by said board to be discontinued the Journal of the board of Trustees of the Town of Gurnett. ever in case of the absence of the clerk the members of said board shall

appoint a clerk Pro Tempore whose powers and duties shall be the same as that of the clerk if present
Sec-4th That all ordinances passed by the Board of Trustees shall be signed by the chairman and attested by the clerk and be recorded by the clerk in a book to be kept by the board to be enumerated ordinance book and within ten days after the passage of an ordinance it shall be the duty of the clerk to have the same published by posting up six written copies thereof in six of the most public places in the Town of Gannett certified to by said clerk to be true copies of such ordinance and the date of the passage thereof

Sec-5th This ordinance to take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided in section four of this ordinance.
