# Dress Code & Important Information

- Core Company- Black Leotard, Pink Tights, and hair off face in a tight bun. Black dance shorts may be added for tap and hip hop audition. Males must wear black dance pants and white top. Must have ballet, jazz (or lyrical turners), tap and hip hop shoes.
- Tap Competition (only)- Black Leotard, black leggings or shorts, and hair off face in a tight bun. Males must wear black pants and white top. Must bring tap shoes.
- Hip Hop Competition (only)- Appropriate athletic attire (black leggings or sweats and white tee or tank (no spaghetti straps) preferred for both males and females, hair must be off face in a tight pony tail. Must bring hip hop sneakers that are only used for dance (no outside street shoes)
- Jazz & Lyrical Competition (only)- Black Leotard, Pink Tights, and hair off face in a tight bun. Males must wear black dance pants and white top. Must have ballet and jazz shoes (or lyrical turners).
- No jewelry or visible bra straps
- Dancers wishing to compete a Solo who did not have one the 2016-2017 season may audition original choreography in the style of dance they wish to compete. Solo auditions will be held after their age level group audition time. Soloists must also perform with group pieces. **Dancers must compete with the team for one year before being eligible for a solo.**
- Please arrive early to be stretched and warmed up before entering into auditions
- Parents will need to attend in order to fill out audition forms
- Auditions are closed to observers. There will be no viewing
- Please prepare your dancer that this is a professional audition. Everyone is on an equal playing field when they walk into the audition room. Each dancer needs to be mentally prepared for any outcome.
- Auditions will be judged by outside teachers & choreographers. These professionals will not be affiliated with the students prior to auditions. Audition score sheets will not be shared with anyone outside of the director of Norwalk Academy of Dance.
