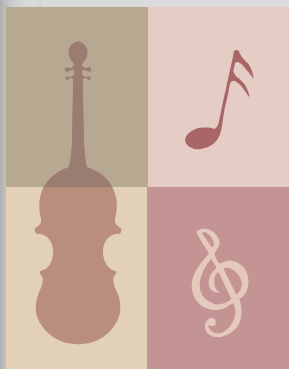

## CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

### REMEMBER...CM Registration is October 1, 2015 through October 31, 2015

CM registration is on your teacher home page at [mtac.org](http://mtac.org).

The Teacher Work Agreement is at [mtaclb.org](http://mtaclb.org) on our new Certificate of Merit page.

After you have enrolled your students in CM you must send me the following, postmarked no later than Nov. 1, 2015.

- 1) One check payable to "MTACLB" including fees for all students
- 2) A print copy of your Student List
- 3) A print copy of the Student Fees List
- 4) The signed Teacher Work Agreement

**PLEASE NOTE:** Our branch CM evaluations are April 2 and 3. Be sure that your families are aware that this is the weekend immediately following Easter Sunday. There are no refunds for CM fees.

It has come to my attention that our branch CM dates of April 2/3 will present a serious conflict for some of our high school students who have mandatory school events at that time. CM does offer make up evaluations (MUPs) for high school students with a valid excuse. The issue is that students who have a MUP are not eligible to be considered for Convention programs.

To solve this problem our branch will schedule an alternative CM date (Sunday, March 6) for those students who meet the following criteria:

1. The student must be currently enrolled in high school, 9th grade or higher.
2. The conflict with the April 2/3 weekend must be a mandatory school activity such as a choir or orchestra trip.
3. The student must provide a written excuse from the teacher to the branch CM Chair to be postmarked Nov. 1.

Please email me if you have students who meet this criteria. You may drop off, scan and email, or mail me the letter from their teacher verifying their school obligation. Again, this letter must be postmarked by November 1st in order for your students to be evaluated on March 6th.

## January Duo Piano Masterclass

### Dear MTACLB Members

#### CALL FOR MASTERCLASS PARTICIPANTS

In keeping with this year's loose theme of collaboration, our January piano master class will be a unique event and special opportunity for your students. We are excited to have Mark Uranker and Althea Waites of CSULB's own Orpheus Duo giving a clinic on duo piano playing on Sunday, January 10<sup>th</sup> at CSULB! Their biographies and information about the Orpheus Duo are attached.

We are looking for four duos (8 total students), each preparing one piece or movement, for this event.

This is a fantastic opportunity for your late intermediate / early advanced students to gain experience collaborating with another like-leveled musician before they get to college, and to explore a new type of music they might not otherwise get the opportunity to perform alongside their solo repertoire.

**Q: What is the intended age/level for this event?**

A: Preference will be given to high school students performing more advanced repertoire (approximate CM levels 6+). College/adult students will also be considered after high school students have taken available spots.

**Q: Is this class intended for two pianos or one piano, four hands?**

A: Preference will be given to students preparing two-piano music. Available space will then be filled by one-piano four hands participants.

**Q: My studio only has one piano, but I have two students I know would be perfect for this opportunity – how can I prepare students for this event?**

A: There are two options: 1) bring in a keyboard to your studio alongside your piano, or 2) book FREE/NO CHARGE TO YOU! time at 2<sup>nd</sup> VP Tasha Locke's home studio – equipped with a small grand and an upright – any day except Thursdays or Sundays.

Deadline for participant sign-ups is December 1.

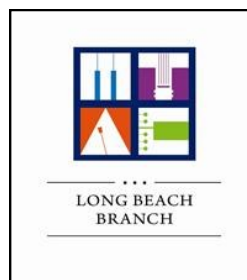
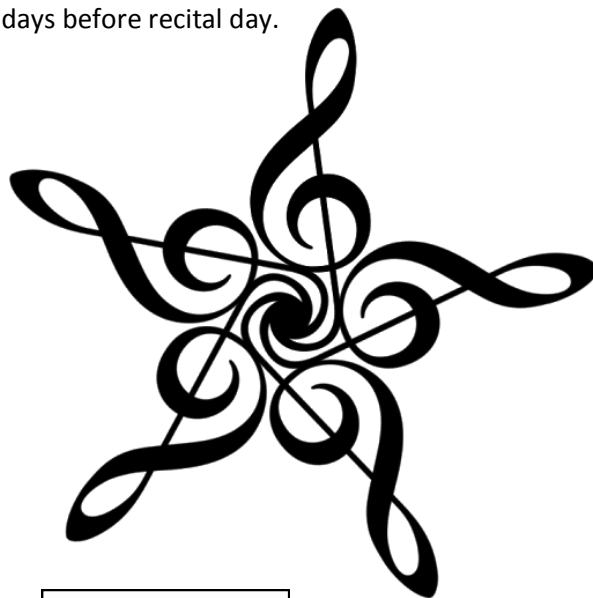
