2015 Branch Honors Recital

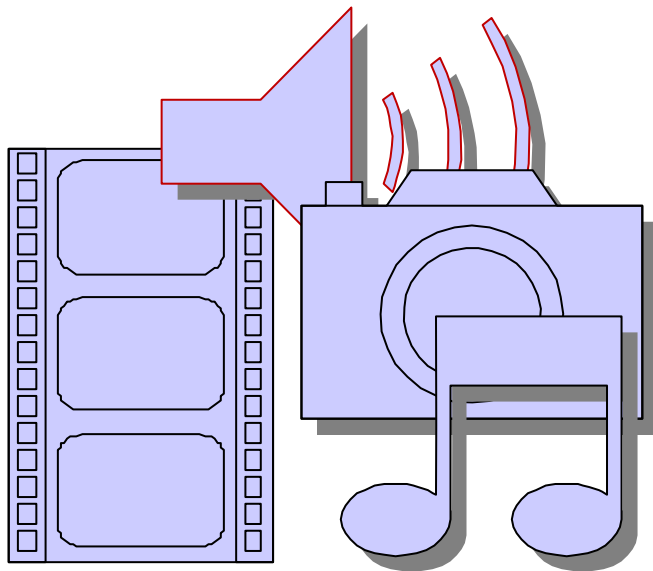
