RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION ADOPTED FEBRUARY 18, 2013 FOR CLARIFICATION ON NONPAYMENT FOR WATER SERVICE WHEN DUE

At a regular meeting of the Village Council of Unionville, Michigan, held at the village hall on October 20, 2014 the following resolution was offered by Trustee David VanHove.

WHEREAS: A resolution adopted on June 20, 1994 set the charge for water service shut-off at \$15.00 and \$15.00 for turn-on due to non-payment and

WHEREAS: A resolution adopted on February 18, 2013 set the charge of \$30.00 if payment for water service is not received before the shut-off date and the DPW is sent to the residence, regardless of whether the resident wishes to make payment at that time or not and

WHEREAS: The Village of Unionville wishes to reserve the right to refuse a personal check in payment for water service when a shut-off notice is involved and require payment be made for full amount of bill in cash or money order only and

THEREFORE: The Village of Unionville, shall continue to charge \$15.00 if the water is shut-off and \$15.00 turn-on due to non-payment and

THEREFORE: The Village of Unionville shall not charge \$15.00 shut-off and \$15.00 turn-on fee if payment is made before the shut-off date, but a \$30.00 charge shall be assessed if payment for water service is not received before the shut-off date and the DPW is sent to the residence, regardless of whether the resident wishes to make payment at that time or not and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The Village of Unionville will reserve the right to refuse a personal check in payment for water service when a shut-off notice is involved and require payment be made for full amount of bill in cash or money order only.
