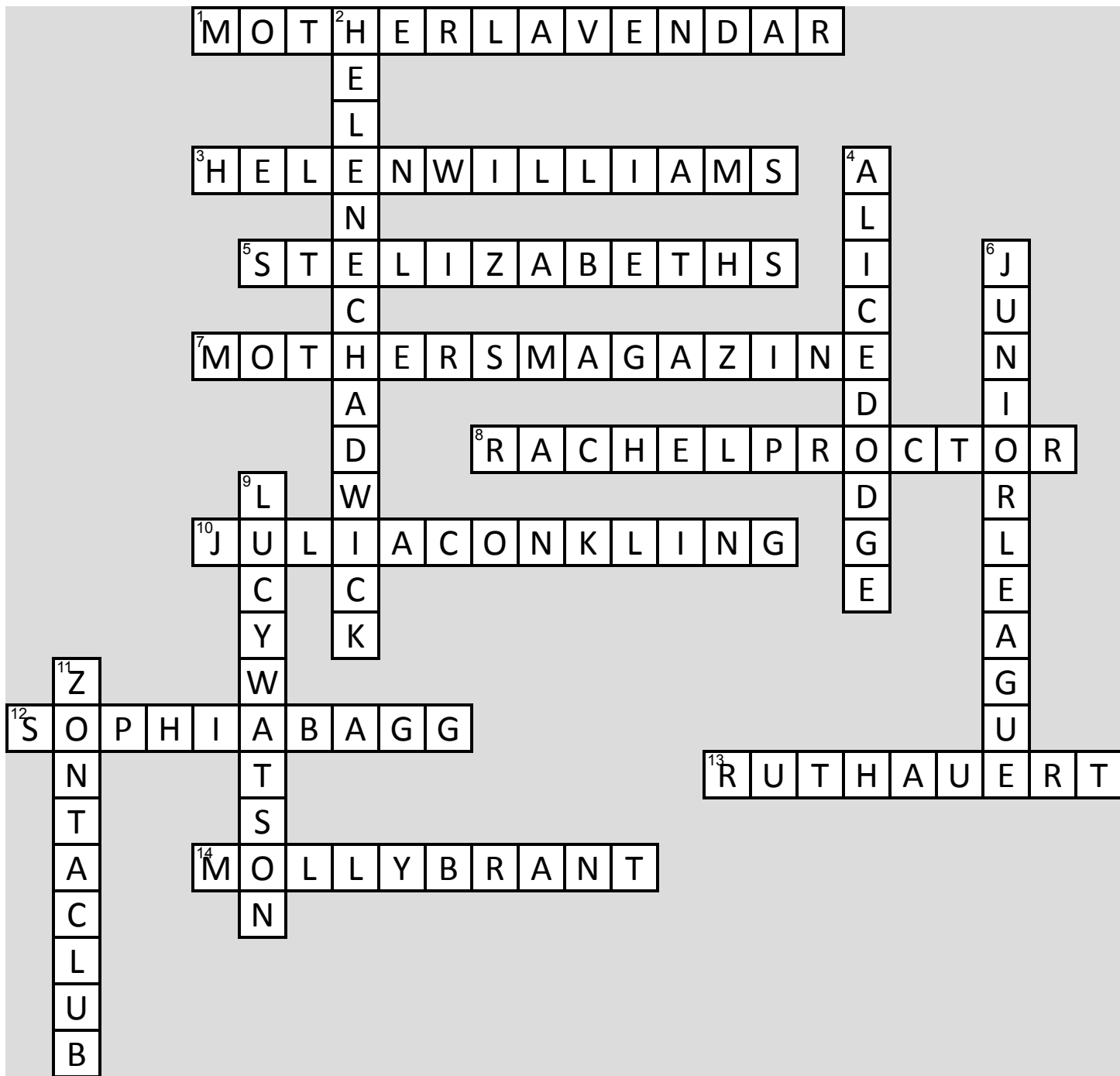


# Just the Gals
