


Glenbrook Community Preschool Newsletter

Cooked Playdough Recipe

Stuck inside this winter? Consider some homemade kitchen fun with your preschooler!

2 cups white flour

1 cup salt

2 Tbsp. cream of tartar

2 cups of water

1 Tbsp. vegetable oil

food colouring

Combine and cook ingredients over medium heat. Turn out onto counter and knead until smooth. Store in an airtight container.

Class Photos

Class photos will be taken on Wednesday, March 14 for the four year old classes and Thursday, March 15 for the three year old classes. The photo session will take only a few minutes, and the rest of the class time will be spent exploring the usual messy preschool fun. Therefore, please choose your child's clothes accordingly. The teachers will let you know after Spring Break when 5x7 prints of the photos are available for \$5 purchase. No individual photos will be taken, only a class photo. This will be done at the very beginning of class so please be on time. Latecomers might not get to be in the photo!

Learning through Play

Carpet time at the end of each class not only teaches children important social skills, like keeping their hands to themselves, but also provides an opportunity for our teachers to share a story with the class. Did you know that books and storytelling help children to:

- Learn pre-reading skills such as how to hold a book
- Learn new words and meanings
- Develop imagination
- Develop their interests
- Understand different social situations
- Understand that print carries the meaning of the story
- Share experiences with other children and adults
- Develop a positive attitude towards books, which will help them when they learn to read
