It's hard to believe we are already entering Advent. Advent is a season of anticipation, a time when we prepare our hearts to celebrate the arrival of Jesus Christ at Christmas. But it's also a season of return - a return to God's presence. This year, we spent much of the fall studying Exile and building up to the idea of the people of God being called to return to the presence, purpose, promise, and providence of God. So this Advent, we take a spiritual journey back to the presence of God much like the Jewish exiles returned from Babylon to their homeland.

This Advent, our sermon series *Traveling Light* will explore how the promise of "return" found in Scripture speaks directly to us today.

The Jewish exile was a time of deep longing for God's presence and a yearning for restoration. When God called His people back to their homeland, it wasn't just a physical return; it was a spiritual invitation to leave behind the heaviness of exile - both their sins and their sorrows—and come back to Him. In the same way, Jesus Christ came into the world to call us out of the darkness of sin and into the light of His grace.

But the journey back to God is not always easy. Like the exiles of old, we often carry burdens that weigh us down—material desires, distractions, bitterness, pain from the past, or even our need to control. These burdens can make it difficult to hear Jesus' call to return and to embrace the life of hope, peace, love, and joy He offers.

This Advent, we invite you to travel light. Through the series *Traveling Light*, we'll reflect on how Jesus calls us to let go of the things that hinder us from drawing near to Him. As we prepare to celebrate the miracle of His birth, let us hear His invitation to come back to God and find rest for our souls.

The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."

Deuteronomy 31:8

Advent is a time of hope—a hope grounded in the promises of God fulfilled through Jesus Christ. Just as the exiles discovered that God's faithfulness was greater than their fears, we can trust that His grace will carry us on the journey home. Let's travel together, unburdened, toward the light of Christmas.

May this season be one of letting go, drawing near, and rediscovering the joy of walking in step with the Savior.

We look forward to traveling with you!





Drop Box Available

First Aid Equipment & Medical Supplies

There is first aid equipment and supplies in the basement kitchen, fellowship hall pantry and church office for your use. There is also an AED in the connecting hallway near the restrooms.

We have been blessed with the donation of a few wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, slings, bandages, ice packs, etc. that would help in a medical situation in the building or for someone in immediate need. These are located in the basement kitchen for your use as needed.

Use of the Church Hall or Basement

Table & Chair Sign Out

There are a number of different ways to give to your church, as listed below:


Give to the church via Sunday offering, US Mail, or drop off (A wooden collection box is located on the wall outside the lower coat room for your convenience throughout the week.)
