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The Children's Lunchbox 2019 Summer Food Program Sites (Open and Enrolled)

The Children's Lunchbox, a program of Bean's Cafe, Inc. is gearing up for its busiest time of year, SUMMER. Now that classes are out and children don't have access to school lunches, we intensify our efforts to help feed some of the estimated 21,000 children in the Anchorage area that don't have enough healthy food to eat.

Meals will be provided to all eligible children free of charge. Acceptance and participation requirements for the Program and all activities are the same for all regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

Please note, **enrolled sites are closed sites, and not open to the public, hence we do not release information for those specific programs.** To enroll in a closed site, one need contact that specific program/agency. The Children's Lunchbox does not handle any enrollment for any food service.

Open sites are open to ALL children ages 18 and under, and do not require any paperwork to enroll to eat for free. The child simply shows up during the meal times and can get a free lunch.
