

Our goal for all of our Children of the church is to have an enriching Christian experience. Let's take a look at how we accomplish this.

1: *Sunday School is a part of Church.* We start Sunday School at 9:40 am and ending at 11:15 am. The Sunday School morning starts at 9:40 am with children listening to the Church Service up until Children's Sermon. After Children's Sermon the children sing one song for the congregation and then leave and go to their classroom; 3K to 1st Grade learn about the Bible and children in 2nd thru 8th Grade reflect on the Sermon and how to connect it with there everyday life. On the 1st and 3rd Sunday when there is Communion everyone that took the Communion Class will participate in Communion and then come back to their classroom to finish their reflection.

2: *Communion.* Any child 2nd grade and above who would like to receive communion and parents feel their child(ren) is ready; Pastor Kary puts together a communion class at the beginning of the year for the children who have not received the class.

3: *Bible:* Any child 3rd grade and above who has not received a Bible Pastor Kary has a class for them half way through the year.

4: *End of year trip.* We have gone to Action City and Huffy's Skate America the last few years. Everyone is welcomed to come to the end of year trip, but how well Sunday School is attended by each individual child will depend on how much Sunday School will pay for your child. Here is a short explanation: I feel Sunday School is just as important as sending my children to Monday thru Friday School. We need both of these schools to live. Monday thru Friday school teaches children the knowledge they need to know to earn money by getting a job; Sunday School teaches the children how to act and how to handle tough situations.

5: *Parents:* The parents have the option to have their children sit with them or we will have a place in church for the children to sit together, if they are not with their parents until it is time for the children to go to their classroom. The best part, after church parent's can stay for coffee hour and chat with others while they wait for a short time while their child(ren) finish up their reflection/lesson.
