Las Vegas Classic Eligibility

The Las Vegas Classic (LVC) presented by 900 Global is open to all adult bowlers who are current United States Bowling Congress (USBC) members and are in good standing with the USBC. The LVC is limited to 150 entries.

Las Vegas Classic Entry Fee

The LVC Entry Fee including three daily Challenge events and the 900 Global Championship is \$800.00. If paid in full by September 1, 2020, the \$800.00 entry fee also includes the Logo Infusion Sweeper scheduled for Monday, February 8. A deposit of \$400.00 will reserve an entry in each of the three daily Challenge events as well as the 900 Global Championship but DOES NOT include the Logo Infusion Sweeper. The total entry fee must be paid in full prior to the start of the official practice session.

Players may enter one or more of the three one-day Challenge events for \$225.00 each. Bowlers entering the Challenge event(s) individually at the \$225 rate will not qualify for the LVC 900 Global Championship Finals. If a bowler chooses to NOT participate in the official practice session, their entry will be accepted up to one hour prior to the start of the event they are entering or until the tournament field is full, whichever occurs first. The LVC is limited to 150 entries. Optional Sweepers, Brackets, Side Pots, and Century Doubles are available at additional cost.

Las Vegas Classic Event Formats

35' Challenge

Qualifying: Six games across twelve lanes on a 35' pattern. Three in ten (or a maximum of 45) plus up to eight Seniors (age 50 and over) below the cut line advance to the Cashers' Round. The Qualifying Leader (or leaders in the event of a tie for Qualifying Leader) is/are automatically seeded into Stepladder Finals.

Cashers' Round: Drop all pins. Lanes re-oiled. Advancing bowlers (including the Qualifying Leader(s)) bowl four games across eight lanes. Top eight advance to Stepladder Finals. If the Qualifying Leader(s) is/are not in the top eight after completion of the Cashers' Round, that/those bowler(s) will be seeded respectively in the lowest positions for the Stepladder Finals and the remaining Stepladder spots will be filled from the Cashers' Round.

Stepladder Finals: Eight-player single game elimination consisting of three matches with three players each (Match 1: Seeds 6, 7, and 8; Match 2: Match 1 winner plus seeds 4 and 5; Match 3: Match 2 winner plus seeds 2 and 3), and a two-player Championship. If the Qualifying Leader is also the Cashers' Round leader, that bowler must be defeated twice in the Stepladder.

39' Challenge

Qualifying: Six games across twelve lanes on a 39' pattern. Top 16 including at least two Seniors advance. Drop all pins. Re-oil lanes.

Bracket Round 1: The 16 qualifiers compete in a seeded (1 vs 16, 2 vs 15, etc.) best-of-five one-game match. Eight winners advance.

Bracket Round 2: Winners from Bracket Round 1 compete in a best-of-three one-game match. Four winners advance.

Semi-Final: Winners from Bracket Round 2 compete in a one-game match on the same pair of lanes. Two winners advance.

Championship: Winners from the semi-final compete in a one-game match. The winner is the 39' Challenge Champion.

43' Challenge

Qualifying: Six games across twelve lanes on a 43' pattern. The top 16 qualifiers including at least 2 Seniors (with less than 96 entries) or the top 24 qualifiers including at least 3 Seniors advance to the Match Play Round.

Match Play: Qualifying pinfall carries over. Lanes re-oiled. Five-game Modified Match Play with 30 bonus pins added to each single game victory (15 bonus pins for ties). Fifth Round is Position Round. Top five advance to Stepladder Finals.

Stepladder Finals: Single game elimination with 5th place bowling 4th place; winner bowling 3rd place, etc.

Las Vegas Classic 900 Global Championship

The top 16, 24, or 32 bowlers as determined by their **combined qualifying positions** from the three previous Challenge events earn a spot in the LVC 900 Global Championship Finals. With 32 finalists, qualifiers 1 through 8 earn two byes and are seeded into Round 3; qualifiers 9 through 16 earn one bye and are seeded into Round 2. The 43' pattern will be on the left lane and the 35' pattern will be on the right lane of each pair.

Bracket Round 1: Qualifiers 17 to 32 compete in a seeded (17 vs 32, 18 vs 31, etc.) best-of-five one-game match. Eight winners advance.

Bracket Round 2: Winners from Bracket Round 1 are matched against qualifiers 9 through 16 in a seeded best-of-five one-game match. Eight winners advance.

Bracket Round 3: Winners from Bracket Round 2 are matched against qualifiers 1 through 8 in a seeded best-of-five one-game match. Eight winners advance.

Bracket Round 4: Winners from Bracket Round 3 compete in a best-of-three one-game match. Four winners advance.

Semi-Final: Winners from Bracket Round 4 compete in a one-game match on the same pair of lanes. Two winners advance.

Championship: Winners from the Semi-Final compete in a one-game match. The Championship match winner is the Las Vegas Classic 900 Global Champion.

CONDUCT

All tournament bowlers shall conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times while in the host center or on the property of the host center and on social media before, during, and after the event. Any criticism by a tournament bowler who discusses the sponsor, host center or personnel, lane conditions or pins, LVC or its staff, or their fellow competitors in an unfavorable manner or who otherwise engages in actions unbecoming a LVC bowler in the opinion of the Tournament Director shall be in violation of the Code of Conduct. Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated on the lanes or inside the tournament venue. Individuals are subject to ejection for engaging in improper tactics or conduct including, but not limited to, physical and verbal abuse toward another person. Anyone found to be in violation of the Code of Conduct will be fined and may be refused entry to the event or disqualified from the competition in which the violation occurred and/or declared ineligible for future competitions.

Penalty: *First offense: \$250; Second offense: \$500; Third offense; \$1,000*

Electronic Media: The LVC regards electronic media such as message boards, conversation pages, and other forms of social networking (such as Facebook and Twitter) as important tools of communication and fan interaction. Tournament participants may not use these platforms to defame or otherwise attack the integrity of the LVC, its members, staff, sponsors, host center, or host center employees.

DRESS CODE (Including Official Practice Session)

A shirt with the participant's name on the back is required for the LVC 900 Global Championship. A named shirt is not required but strongly encouraged for other LVC events. Name lettering must be at least two inches in height. Paper name plaques are not acceptable. Men must wear dress slacks. Women must wear dress slacks, skirts, or skorts. Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to:

- Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, hats (medical reason only), etc.
- Workout attire, t-shirts, shorts, short skirts, bib overalls
- Cords, jeans, or any kind of denim

I warrant that I am a USBC member. I agree to abide by all tournament playing rules and regulations prescribed by LVC, including all provisions set forth on this form. I specifically agree for myself and any replacement chosen by me or for me that if I am not eligible for participation and/or cannot bowl in the LVC, then my prize, bowling, and expense fees shall be forfeited and all sums tendered by me as prize, bowling, and expense fees may be retained by LVC as liquidated damages. The entrant whose name appears hereon or my authorized replacement hereby agrees that the LVC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees, less expenses, if and when that entrant shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency, or emergencies or causes relating thereto resulting therefrom, fires, labor difficulties, terrorism or threats of terrorism, or other causes beyond the control of LVC. I further agree that LVC may use my name and likeness (including video) for promotional purposes at no cost to me and with no fees being paid to me.

The entrant whose name appears on this application and/or authorized replacement hereby agrees that the LVC and its officers and agents shall not be liable for any injury resulting from participation in an LVC tournament, absent willful or gross negligence on the part of the LVC.
