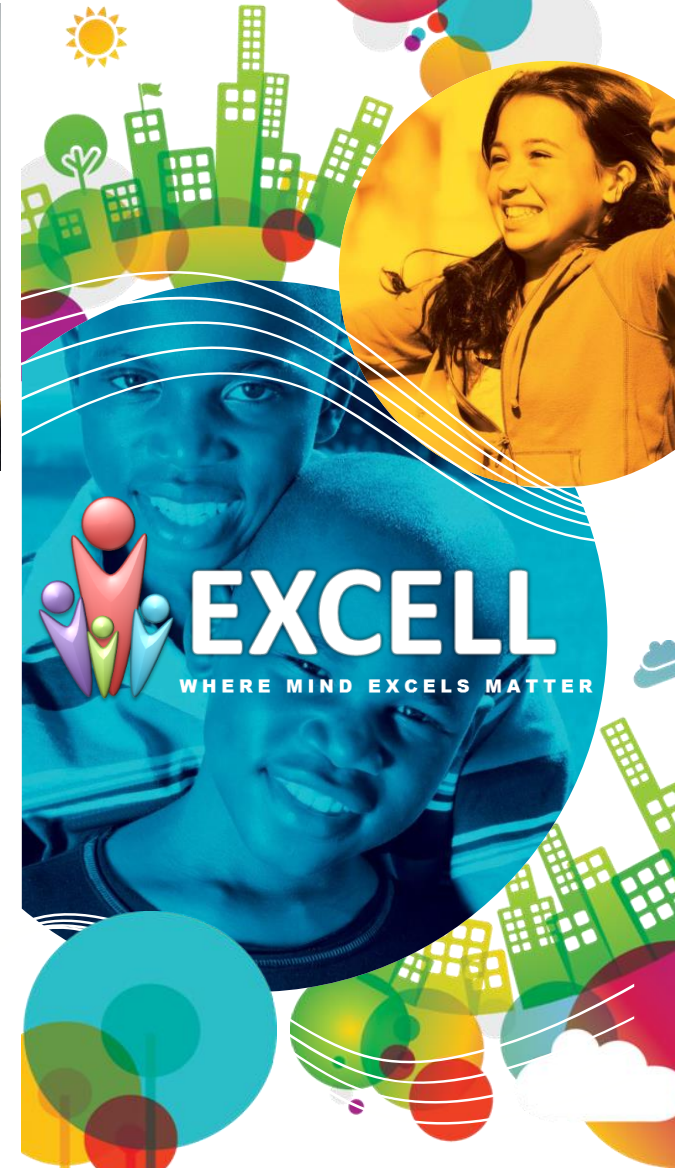

Motor Mayhem
