#### Pastoral Reflection

Advent is a Marian season. Not only do we wait with Mary as she prepares to give birth to the Messiah, we also celebrate several important feast days. The first of course is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception on December 8, which is also a Holy Day of Obligation. This feast reminds us that Mary was freed from sin by her Savior from the first moment of her conception. Unlike the rest of us, she was not born with original sin, but was conceived in her mother's womb already "full of grace." This was not something she earned but a gift from God, the same gift we receive at our Baptism.

December 12 is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, which is important to everyone living in the Americas, but especially to the people of Mexico. The story of St. Juan Diego and the apparition of Mary to him in 1531, reminds us that God's love extends to all his children, no matter where they are from. This feast is especially meaningful as we unite ourselves with our immigrant brothers and sisters who are far from their homes but take comfort in the loving care of our Blessed Mother.

Pope Francis had a deep devotion to the mother of Jesus, popularizing the image of Our Lady, Undoer of Knots. So, it is not surprising that in 2019 he added a feast to the Church Calendar on December 10, honoring Our Lady of Loreto. Loreto, Italy is famous for having the house of Mary, which was miraculously transported to that spot in 1294. What is important about this legend is the reminder that Mary lived in a home, just as we all do, and that she, Joseph, and Jesus lived within its walls as a family. During Advent this feast is a reminder of the importance of family during the hectic days leading to Christmas.

May your Advent Days be filled with light, joy and peace, and may Blessed Mary guide your steps. Fr. Larry


