2019 Year End Award Rules

- 1. Once a Rider/Horse Combination enters one of the shows that is part of the Oklahoma Eventing Circuit, they are eligible for year end awards.
- 2. Champion and Reserve Champion prizes along with 1st thru 6th place ribbons will be awarded to horse/rider combinations based upon points earned during the calendar year at horse trials or combined tests held at the following facilities Feather Creek Farm, Celtic Cross Equestrian Center and Southern Hills Riding Academy. Year End Awards will be given for the following divisions: Training, Senior Novice, Junior Novice, Senior Beginner Novice, Junior Beginner Novice, Senior Starter, Junior Starter, Senior Introductory, and Junior Introductory. The Junior and Senior divisions will be combined if less than six in each division for year end awards.
- 3.An Overall Rider of the Year Award for both Seniors and Juniors will be awarded. This will include all points accumulated by a rider/horse combination. A rider/horse combination can move up or down only one division for points to count.
- 4. Must be a current member of the Oklahoma Combined Training Association (OCTA) prior to the show. Can enter at the show prior to riding. Must attend 2 Oklahoma Eventing Circuit shows during that award year.
- 5. Senior riders are 19 and over; Junior riders are 18 years old and under (age on January 1st of that year).
- 6. Divisions Defined: **Dressage** Training, Novice, & Beg. Novice Corresponding 2018 USEA tests, Starter & Introductory Intro. Level test (walk/trot only); **Stadium Jumping** Training 3'3", Novice-2'9", Beg. Novice 2'7", Starter-2'4", and Introductory Level 18" crossbars; **Cross Country Jumping** Training 3'3", Novice-2'9", Beg. Novice 2'7", Starter-2'4", and Introductory Level 2'.
