INFORMATION FOR NEW HOMEOWNERS

Welcome to Big Mountain Homeowners Association! The FAQ below will answer many of the common questions posed by new homeowners.

What do my dues cover?

- If you own a home or townhome, dues are assessed for 1) access to the trash compactor building near the Fire Hall, 2) maintenance of HOA common property and general HOA expenses and, 3) driveway snow removal.
- If you own a vacant lot, dues cover maintenance of HOA common property and general HOA expenses.

When are dues assessed?

• Dues statements are sent in early January, shortly following the annual meeting.

When is the annual meeting?

• The annual meeting of Big Mountain Homeowners Association is usually held in early January.
