Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, East District Commissioner, Chet Owen, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance and led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve today's agenda and approve the minutes from the October 25th meeting with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Christy Humerickhouse of Veregy gave an update on Sunset Nursing Home. Windows should be finished next week, roof will be 3 or 4 more weeks. The water furnace was installed October 31 and Christy will check with the sign company to see if they plan to set the base for the new sign before the scheduled install date of February.

The new lease has been sent to Lincoln Health but County Clerk, Melissa Meek has not heard back from them as of today, November 1, 2022.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White signed checks for Region D and attended a Tri-County Health meeting.

The Commission approved the document appointing them all to Region D for year 2022-2023

West District Commissioner, Kyle White gave an update on the ACCD district.

Garry McFee of Howe & Company gave an update on the status of acquiring easements for the bridge work on Fairmount Rd. 2 of the 3 easements have been acquired.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll signed the agreement for the copiers for the Clerk, Collector and Assessor's Offices. These copiers are ones that are already in place the agreement is to upgrade the current equipment.

At 10 a.m. bids were opened for brush removal for Joseph P. Shost, John Gary Gibson and Michael Lee. Bids were received from Chris Franks and Lucas Tunk's. The bids were all tabled until 11 a.m. where at that time West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the bids for Shost and Lee to Chris Franks and approve the bid for Lee to Lucas Tunk's. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second. All in favor, Carrol-aye, White-aye, and Owen-aye. Motion carried 3-0. In attendance to the bidding opening was Chris Franks.

Alan Gillette of Camden Township met with the Commission to discuss brush concerns and the law associated with brush.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll and County Clerk, Melissa Meek signed the quarterly reimbursement for Assessor Tanya Zimmerman.

Collector/Treasurer Jessica Lee presented the October adjustment register for the Commission to review and sign.

The Commission talked to United Fiber about the road that was cut at Shagbark by their contractors. United Fiber advised they will repair the cut.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gary met with the Commission to discuss brush. The Commission discussed using the wash bay to maintain county vehicles. They also discussed getting a bid to put up a power door and lights in the storage building using a small solar set up,

Sheriff Kasey Keesaman advised he had been notified of trailer in roadway on Maple. He also discussed DDRJ (DeKalb Daviess Regional Jail) staffing issues and fund balances.

East District Commissioner, Chet Owen reminded everyone that the Historical Society would hold a rededication at Heritage Park on November 9th

Some dates to remember November 6th the Extension Council will be holding a chili cookoff at the Conley Building, November 8th the General Election, November 9th a rededication at Heritage Park, November 11th the Courthouse will be closed in honor of Veteran's Day, and the Courthouse will be closed November 24 and 25 for Thanksgiving.

The DeKalb County Commissioners, DeKalb County Prosecutor and the DeKalb County Sheriff is urging the public to vote NO on amendment 3 on November 8. This amendment would legalize recreational marijuana in Missouri making Missouri's law more liberal than Colorado's. Twenty five percent of Colorado traffic fatalities now involve marijuana impaired drivers. Amendment 3 would create the position "Chief Equity Officer" to establish public education programs and more in its 30 some pages. Amendment 3 creates bad government and should be not added to the Missouri constitution.

The Commission will be hosting the NW Commissioner's in March of 2023.

With no other business before the Commission, West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn until November 8, 2022. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second.

All in favor. Motion carried.
