**RESOLUTION NO.: SL - 15 - 2026**

**TITLE: APPROVAL TO ACCEPT BUDGET YEAR (FY) 2025  
SUPPLEMENTAL HIP/TTP FUNDS FROM BUREAU OF INDIAN  
AFFAIRS, WESTERN REGION**

**WHEREAS,** the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 8, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and

**WHEREAS,** the Summit Lake Paiute Council has the responsibility for the general welfare of its tribal membership including tribal natural resources; and

**WHEREAS,** the Summit Lake Paiute Council is the duly constituted governing body within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and

**WHEREAS,** the Summit Lake Paiute Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect, and advance the views, interest, education, resources, and general welfare of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe membership; and

**WHEREAS,** the Summit Lake Paiute Council supports natural resources management that protects, conserves, and enhances plants and wildlife native to the Summit Lake basin and aboriginal area of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Summit Lake Paiute Council has organized a Natural Resources Department (NRD) to provide technical expertise and services to manage air, water, soil, fish, wildlife, and plants within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation and off Reservation areas considered the aboriginal homeland of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe, and to manage Reservation infrastructure such as roads; and

**WHEREAS,** in February 2026 the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe received the Notice of Funding Availability – Budget Year 2025 Highway Infrastructure Programs (HIP) - Tribal Transportation Program (TTP), in which the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), Western Region, was pleased to announce the availability of Budget Year (FY) 2025 supplemental HIP/TTP funds; and

**WHEREAS,** the Summit Lake Paiute Council wishes to accept the funds and apply the entire allocation of \$22,970.96 to road maintenance activities, which is an approved activity on the currently approved FY22 – 26 TTIP; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby approves to accepting the funds from the BIA Western Region for the purpose described above; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Summit Lake Paiute Council does not waive, alter, or otherwise diminish its Sovereign Immunity, whether expressed or implied, by virtue of this grant contract for any and all administrative or legal action which may arise directly or indirectly from the same. Furthermore, the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairwoman to execute any instruments as may be necessary and appropriate to accomplish the above-mentioned actions in the name of and on behalf of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe.
