GENERAL RULES

- The ORDA Board Race Meet adopts the rules and regulations of the North Dakota Racing Commission.
- 2. Applications for stalls shall be made in advance with the ORDA Board. Payments for stalls just be in full with the application. Stalls assigned on a first pay basis.
- 3. Nominations and sustain payments must be postmarked by the date specified. The United States Postal Service stamp indicating the date of the mailing shall be final as the validity of the date of mailing of any nominations or sustaining payments.
- There will be no refunds of accepted fees for nominations unless the race is cancelled or drawn out.
- 5. Any checks dishonored or returned by the bank for any reason shall cancel eligibility.
- 6. Officials of the ORDA Board Race Meet reserve the right to cancel or postpone any race or trials for any reason, which it deems good and sufficient. If horses are scratch from stakes races leaving only four (4) horses or less (ND Bred races only) and less than six otherwise, race may be cancelled and scratched horse or horses will lose eligibility to enter the following entry day. If trials are not required, the field will be limited to eight horses based on money earned in 2021-2022, starter and draw.
- 7. The decision of the race stewards in all matters shall be final and entries are accepted only on the condition that those persons nominating and or starting a horse in trials and or stakes agree to abide by the decision of the stewards.
- 8. The stewards must approve changes of horse ownership.
- 9. Horse papers will be held until all payments are paid in full. Papers must be signed out by trainer or owner only.
- 10. Claim forms must be filled out completely and with sufficient accuracy to identify the claim in writing on forms provided by the association prior to the time the horse leaves the paddock in a locked claim box maintained for that purpose by the stewards. The claim box will be in the bookkeeper's office. Funds to claim a horse must be in cash, cashier's check or certified check and must be deposited in owner's account the full claiming price and applicable taxes as established by the racing secretary's conditions. Personal checks will not be accepted if intended for claiming purposes.
- 11. Trial races shall be run consecutively. Should a malfunction occur with electric timers on any trials, all finalists will then be selected by order of finish. Should a horse be disqualified, he will be given the time of the horse he is immediately placed behind plus 1/100 of a second.
- 12. The top eight (8) qualifying horses shall be eligible for the finals.
- 13. When applying for stalls, each horse must be listed and the owners name and complete mailing address, and social security number. If not completed correctly, the application will be returned.
- 14. Stall rent is \$50.00 per horse per meet. Stall rent is due with application. The ORDA Board must approve any changes in stall assignments. Stall applications will be enforced and the race conditions will be written according to applications. There will be no pony stalls, tack stalls, or two-year stalls unless nominated into a futurity due to a shortage of stall space. There will be shipping stalls and pony stalls available outside. No horse may be stabled unless it has a negative Coggins, including in-state horses.
- 15. Added money on <u>all</u> stakes and feature races will be reduced if there are less than six starters in the gate. Reduction will be at the discretion of track management.
- 16. Where conditions require trials and if there are more than 8 but fewer than 12 entries,
- 17. Positions will be determined at time of entry, by money earned in 2021-2022, starter, and draw.
- 18. By State Rule, all owners/trainers are required to have Workmen's Compensation for their employees.
- 19. All North Dakota Certified Bred Horses must have the State Race Commission stamp to be considered for the North Dakota Bred races and or breed money.
- 20. For those stabling horses and using Chippewa Downs facilities for training, stall rent is \$25.00 per stall per month, March 1, 2023 to May 31, 2021 and post meet.
- 21. It is the owners or trainers responsibility to keep enough money in their account for all jock mount and saddling fees. All jock mounts must be paid before the first race of the day, failure to do so

- will result in your horse being scratched from the race and a steward's fine for non-compliance with ORDA Association Track rules.
- 22. All exercise riders and jockeys must wear a protective vest and helmet while on the racetrack. Failure to do so will result in a fine from the track stewards.
- 23. Chippewa Downs will use a preference date system. Horses will not be able to receive a date until their official papers are on file with the racing secretary.
- 24. All horse papers received in the race office *prior to* entry will receive a zero, which is the lowest possible race date. A horse keeps the zero until they run or scratch.
- 25. A zero takes preference over a running date.
- 26. Maidens entering against winners will receive least preference, unless a certified ND race is offered as ND certified preferred. ND certified will have first preference.
- 27. Preference dates will supersede conditions of a race. (Winners preferred, high weights preferred, etc.).
- 28. Any horse running in a stake will retain previously held preference date.
- 29. A horse will lose their preference date once their papers are withdrawn from the race office, unless it is for just cause (i.e., tattoo, corrections, stamped, change of ownership).
- 30. Acceptance of the license or permit from the commission by any permittee or licensee is deemed a consent to search and inspection by the commission pursuant to these rules, and to the seizure of any prohibited medication, drugs, paraphernalia, or devices.
- 31. The ND Racing Commission, through its employees or agents, or through employees of Chippewa Downs, so authorized by the commission, may search and inspect for prohibited medication, drugs, drug paraphernalia, or any electrical or mechanical equipment usable to affect the condition or racing condition of a horse or any item prohibited by these rules, at any time without notice. Such search and inspection may be made of the following: 1. Association stables, receiving barns, the paddock, jockey's room, supply rooms, blacksmith, and similar services shops or areas, including living quarters or private vehicles located within enclosure of the association grounds; and 2. The person, employee, or agent of any licensee while upon the association grounds in the prescribed areas described in subsection 1.
- 32. The North Dakota Racing Commission has adopted the ARCI Controlled Therapeutic Medication Schedule Version 2.1, the Uniform Classification Guidelines for Foreign Substances and Recommended Penalties Version 7.00 and the Multiple Medication Violation Penalty System. These rules can be found on the Racing Commission website.
- 33. No horse may be started unless the horse has raced or has an approved timed workout satisfactory to the stewards. Such workouts must have occurred on the grounds of a licensed Para-mutual facility within the previous thirty days. A horse, which has not started for a period of sixty days or more, is ineligible to race until it has completed a timed workout satisfactory to the stewards prior to the day of the race in which the horse is entered. No horse may be taken onto the track for training or a workout except during hours designated by the association.
- 34. Officials will be available at the track for timed workouts; schedules will be posted in the secretary's office.
- 35. Horses running for the 1st time around the turn need approved work within 30 days of entry.
- 36. If a race is declared a "no race", the purse shall be distributed evenly to all participants or the funds shall be returned to their source. In the event it is determined that funds shall be returned:

 1. All funds provided by the commission must be returned to the commission except where an association returns the funds to their purse pool and uses then to fund subsequent races, and 2. Nomination, entry fees, or similar payments by horsemen for eligibility in the race shall be returned to the horsemen.
- 37. Paint horses that meet the race conditions will be allowed to run in Chippewa Downs sponsored Quarter Horse races. NDQHRA sponsored QH races will remain restricted.

*High-weights will be determined by money earned in last two years.

REMINDER NOTES:

Entries for Saturday races will be taken on Wednesday and entries for Sunday will be taken on Thursday. Scratch time is 45 minutes before stake races and 8AM on race day for all other races.

Horse with original papers on file in the race office will be preferred. Thoroughbreds with on-line registrations shall have their information accessed through the Jockey Club interactive registry system.

All horses brought to Chippewa Downs must have a current health certificate that must be presented to the racing secretary's office with the horse's papers. This includes out of state as well as North Dakota horses and must be dated with 10 days of entering the racetrack grounds.

EQUINE HERPES VACINE WILL **BE REQUIRED.** No horse will be stabled unless it has a negative Coggins, including in-state horses. Any incomplete or inaccurate health certificates will be returned to the Board of Animal Health in the originating state.

On all certified races: The registration papers must be "North Dakota Certified Stamped" at time of entry.

On Chippewa Downs Open Futurity, Derby and Stakes, entry preferred by money earned in 2021 or 2022.

No horse will be eligible to start in any race without a tattoo or digital tattoo.

\$100.00 MONTHLY CAMPING CHARGE

Veterinary Services

The State Veterinarian(s) and Association Veterinarian will be available to provide private services as requested. Each horseman or horseman's representative will be presented with a receipt at the time services are rendered. The horseman or horseman's representative may sign the receipt to authorize payment for the services to be debited from the horseman's account.

If the horseman or horseman's representative does not sign the receipt, payment will not be debited from the horseman's account. In such cases, the horsemen's account will be held until notified by the attending vet that payment for his services has been made.

Race Day Lasix Administration

Any horseman requesting a horse be administered race day Lasix <u>must</u> complete the North Dakota Racing Commission form entitled REQUEST TO USE LASIX for each horse.

The night before each race day, the state veterinarian will post a schedule for administration of race day Lasix. It is the horseman's responsibility to be present at his stalls at the designated time. The schedules will be posted in the following locations:

(Chippewa)

Barns 1 and 2 - EAST ENTRANCE Barns 3 and 4 - WEST ENTRANCE

JOCKEY AND DRIVER SAFETY

- 1) As soon as a problem with the condition of the racetrack or hazardous weather is identified as a safety risk, the jockeys must immediately notify the racetrack official and stewards.
- 2) **Lightning:** The jockeys and drivers should not be asked to leave the paddock when lightning storms are in the immediate vicinity. The jockey's, drivers, trainers, and track management should attempt to complete the racing card if reasonably possible, after the storm system has cleared the area.
- 3) **Unsafe Track Conditions:** The stewards shall notify the track manager of any problem concerning the safety conditions of the racetrack. The track manager will try to rectify the situation as soon as possible.
 - a) As soon as the problem has been addressed, the track manager, the jockeys or drivers, the trainers, and management will physically review the area in question. If all are in agreement that the problem is corrected, racing will proceed. If any one of the aforementioned groups is still not satisfied, the jockeys or drivers will give the track manager additional time to correct the problem.
 - b) A vote by the jockeys or drivers will not take place until the racetrack has had the opportunity to correct the problem. Should the jockeys or drivers remain unsatisfied after the track manager has attempted to correct the problem, a vote will be taken by the jockeys and drivers who are scheduled to compete on the remainder of the card and the jockeys or drivers will determine if racing will proceed. If the majority of eligible jockeys or drivers agree not to continue, racing will be cancelled. The stewards and/or management will monitor the procedure and announce the outcome. No horsemen, owners, or members of track management are allowed in the jockeys/drivers room during the voting process.
 - c) In the event that a sufficient number of jockeys or drivers vote to continue racing and a jockey or driver who is scheduled to ride remains concerned about his/her safety, that jockey or driver may take off their scheduled commitments without repercussions from management, stewards and/or the state racing commission.
- 4) Cold Weather: All parties agree that racing may be cancelled in the event that the wind chill factor is recorded at below thirty-degrees (32 degrees) at the agreed upon times. A committee will meet at 11 a.m. or 6 p.m. that day with jockeys, trainers, stewards, and track management. No vote will be taken if the wind chill factor is above thirty-two degrees (32 degrees). A jockey or driver may, however, take off mounts with no repercussions from management, stewards and/or the state racing commission.
- 5) Hot Weather: All parties agree that racing may be cancelled in the event that the head index is recorded at one hundred five (105 degrees) or warmer at the agreed upon times. A committee will meet at 11 a.m. or 6 p.m. that day with jockeys or drivers, trainers, stewards, and track management. No vote will be taken if the heat index is below one hundred five (105 degrees). A jockey or driver may, however, take off their remaining commitments with no repercussions from management, stewards and/or the state racing commission

Other factors that may affect the weather during extremely hot days may include a breeze or lack of breeze and if it is partly cloudy or if there are no clouds to shield the sun.

RACE MEET NOTICE HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT

It is clearly understood and agreed that this is not a lease of any space, but is merely a revocable license or permit granted by Chippewa Downs, only on the terms and conditions set forth, and Chippewa Downs reserves the unrestricted right to decline stall space, to revoke this license or permit at will and to have any stall or stalls vacated without liability therefore. Chippewa Downs and/or their officers, agents or employees, will not, under any circumstances be liable or responsible for any losses, injuries or damages to person, property caused or suffered by any horse owners, trainers, their agents, servants or employees, and/or horses while on the grounds of Chippewa Downs Race Track. All risk of loss, injury, damage or destruction to person, property, and/or by fire, theft, accident, or otherwise are assumed in full by such owners, trainers, and their agents, servants and employees, whether caused by act or passive negligence, condition of the premises to other reasons or cause whatsoever. This provision shall not be deemed waived by the fact that Chippewa Downs does presently, or will in the future, furnish insurance coverage against injury to jockeys competing or training on the race track. All owners and trainers do hereby reservedly and without exception agree to hold Chippewa Downs harmless from any loss, cost of damage caused by ORDA, their employee. agents, property or horses on the premises of the Chippewa Downs Race Track. By entering the premises, you hereby agree to this clause.

2023 Conditions for NDRC Grant Recipients

1. PURSE FUND GRANT CONDITIONS

- a. The Purse funds awarded by the Racing Commission must be printed in the condition book and the racing program for the race they are being used. The awarded funds must be stated for the specific race and the Racing Commission must be named as the grantor. Example: Purse \$4,000 (\$3,000 provided by NDRC, \$1,000 provided by ORDA/HRND/TBA/NDQHRA).
- b. Purse Funds are limited to 8 Races per day.
 - a. Required Certified-bred Races for 1 Quarter Horse Race and 1 Thoroughbred Race each day.
- c. All Purses must be paid out in full as announced. If the horse race field is reduced below the announced payout distribution formula, unpaid purse funds must be divided between the finishers equally.
- d. Purse Funds awarded by the NDRC and not paid out must be returned to the NDRC Purse Fund within 60 days of the end of the meet. Failure to return unpaid funds disqualifies the recipient from the next year's funding requests eligibility pool.
- e. No changes to purses may be made after entries except in the case of an emergency. All events being designated as an emergency will be at the sole discretion of the NDRC Executive Director.
- f. All races in the condition book including extras, and overnights must have a purse announced with the initial race entry announcement.

2. PROMOTION FUND GRANT CONDITIONS

a. Each promotion fund recipient must provide a verbal and written report at the November NDRC meeting.

3. GENERAL GRANT CONDITIONS

- a. The Commission shall withhold 10% of the total of Promotion Fund awards over \$50,000 to ensure conformance with all grant conditions.
- b. The Condition Book must be submitted to the NDRC Executive Director for approval no less than 60 days prior to the first race date. All changes to the condition book must be submitted to the Executive Director for approval before those changes can be implemented.
- c. The governing board of the entity receiving the grant dollars must review and approve the expenditure report for the Racing Commission no later than 60 days after the conclusion of the race meet. The report is to include an itemized balance sheet, profit & loss statement, and copies of receipts of the payments and expenses. Additionally, a report of each day's paid attendance and pari-mutuel handle and tax liability must be submitted.

These reports will then be submitted to the racing commission for review no later than October 31 of the year of the race meet. Failure to provide all information and reports in a timely and complete manner will cause the forfeiture of the 10% withheld funds.

- d. All reports will be reviewed by the Executive Director and a briefing presented to the Commission during the final meeting each calendar year. If there are further questions the recipient must respond within 15 days, in writing to the Executive Director.
- e. Any violations of these conditions may jeopardize awarding of future grant requests.

Race Rules for Chippewa Downs Races (Stamped Certified Bred Races)

The following rules apply both to the North Dakota Derby/Futurity Stamped Certified Bred Races

- You must pay a NDTA membership of \$50.00 prior to June 1 in order to be eligible to race. This includes all
 members of a partnership or corporation.
- · The horse must be stamped certified bred
- A fee of \$50.00 is <u>due before</u> May 1 of the race year to nominate
- If the payment due date falls on a Sunday or Holiday, payments must be postmarked PRIOR to due date.
- Any discrepancies will be settled by the NDTA Board of Directors.
- · Any insufficient funds check will automatically cancel your nomination.
- If less than 7 starters, only the number of places run will be paid out.
- If less than 4 enter, the race will be cancelled.
- If the race is not run, only those still eligible at the time of cancellation will be refunded their individual nomination fees less 10% retainage.
- Transferring ownership of an eligible horse, regardless of the new address of the new owner, does not effect the
 eligibility of the horse, providing the new owner is a member of NDTA.
- NSF or Stopped Payments will be cause for an immediate suspension of membership.

Purse distribution will be 50% for the first place; 20% for second place; 10% for third place; 7% for fourth place; 6% for fifth place; 4% for sixth place; and 3% for the seventh place. The NDTA will present awards to winning horses.

NOTE: You do not have to run in the futurity to be eligible to run in the derby.
