SPECIFICATIONS FOR CAR COVERS [OPTIONAL]

Adopted by Board of Directors 04.01.2014

The Board adopted the following specifications for Car Covers that owners may install use to cover their vehicles to help protect them from the environment.

1. Two types of Car Covers are allowed, "Custom Fit" which are designed to fit your specific make and model vehicle, or "Contour Fit" which are designed to roughly conform to the size and shape of your vehicle.
2. Car covers must be gray/silver in color. [Gray/silver is best in terms of hiding dirt and looking clean].
3. They must be designed for outdoor use
4. They must be securely fastened to prevent coming off in the wind
5. Covers should have elasticized corners that resist tears and snags and have tie-down straps that go under the vehicle to keep it securely in place.
6. They must be kept in good condition, not ripped or torn.

It is recommended you select a cover that is waterproof and affords maximum resistance to high humidity, mold and rain and one that is washable.
