Exhibitors:

- Rules will follow ND Junior Point Show rules. Please see schedule for final check in times.
- Entries may be for either Junior Points (8-22), Open Class or both
- You must own your animal you are showing.
- Due to increased numbers, we ask that you bring generators to run fans, blowers, etc.
- Exhibitors need to furnish their own bedding for all livestock.
- Shows will be done **one species at a time** with next species beginning when the previous is finished.
- Show Order Saturday – Swine & Dairy Goats, Beef, Sheep, Meat Goats
- Show Order Sunday – Swine, Beef, Sheep, Meat Goats
- ALL Saturday Open Class Show exhibitors AND Sunday Open Class/Junior Point Show exhibitors **MUST** pre-register online at www.mortoncountyfair.com .
 - Registration is required by Friday, July 23, 2021
 - Late registrations will not be accepted. If you anticipate showing, please pre-register!
 - For scratches, let Jackie know by 5:00 pm Friday for the Saturday show and 5:00 pm Saturday for the Sunday show.
- There will NOT be an Overall Round Robin Showmanship Contest
- Showmanship will be judged during the judging, call backs may or may not be held
- The following Showmanship Exhibitor ages are as of Oct 1 of previous yr:
 - Jr – 13 yrs and under
 - Sr – 14 yrs and over
- The following Horse Showmanship Halter Class Exhibitor ages are as of Sept 1 of previous yr:
 - Jr – 13 yrs and under
 - Sr – 14 to 18 yrs
 - Old Timers – 19 yrs and above
- After the show(s) on Saturday, there will be a Barn Meeting for all exhibitors. Please contact your barn boss for further information the day of the show.

- All animal species stalls, pens and cages must be cleared and cleaned of debris once vacated or premiums will be withheld.
 - Beef exhibitors must move bedding away from the walls into the center of the barns.
 - Poultry and Rabbit exhibitors must clean up debris and waste from ground and cages and must wash cages and trays, then fold and stack them.
- All premium checks will be mailed out after the fair.
- Release of all Open Class livestock, including poultry and rabbits, will be 2:00 pm on Sunday.

Saturday Open Class Show and Sunday Open Class/Junior Point Show:

- No entry fee for Saturday's Open Class Show
- Entry fee for Sunday's Open Class/Junior Point Show is
 - \$20 per head for cattle
 - \$15 per head for sheep, meat goats and swine
