MICHIGAN PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE
THE SAFETY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF SMART METERS***

Offers the Following Resolution:*

WHEREAS, DTE is installing AMI meters, also known as smart meters, in southeastern Michigan; and

WHEREAS, smart meters measure and record electricity usage with digital technology utilizing radio frequency waves to transmit data to DTE; and

WHEREAS, concerns about the smart meters have been raised regarding chronic long-term exposure to radio frequency radiation, privacy violations and security issues

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SPEAKING FOR AND ON BEHALF OF ALL COUNTY CITIZENS AS FOLLOWS:
