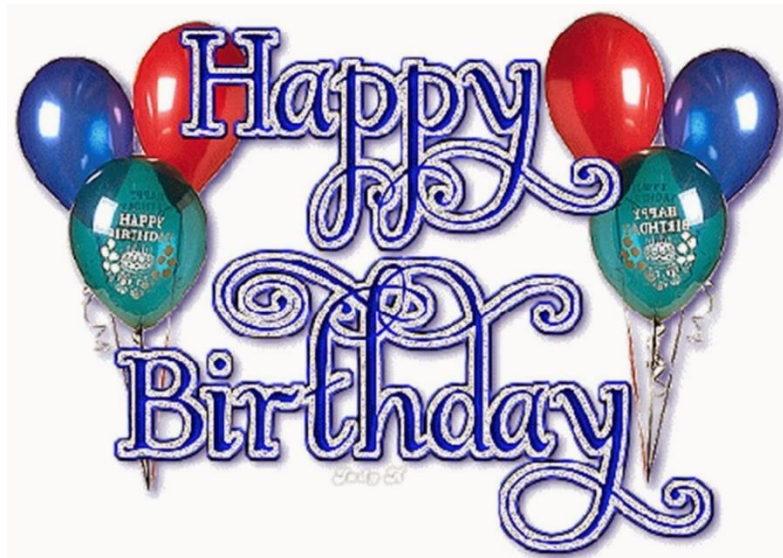

OUTER WEAR
