Job Title: Water Treatment Plant Operator I (Source Water Maintenance)
Department: Public Works/Utilities/Water Treatment Plant
Supervisor: Water Plant Superintendent/ Assistant Superintendent
Hours of Work: Monday – Friday (7:30 am – 4:00 pm) unless performing relief operations
Every third Sunday (8:00am – 4:00pm) unless performing relief operations
Incumbent will be responsible for operating the plant on a fill in basis
Hourly Pay: 8A- \$20.68 - \$26.73 (No Water Supply Certificate)
10A- \$22.48 - \$29.10 (Class 1 Water Supply Certificate or higher)

Job Description Summary:

Nature and Scope:

The Water Treatment Plant is a division within the Utilities Department of the Public Works Group and reports to the Water Treatment Plant Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent. General supervision is received from these plant supervisors; however, the employee is expected to perform without detailed instruction. The Water Plant Operator I (Source Water Maintenance) performs monitoring, preventative maintenance and repairs at the City's source water locations and treatment plant.

Job Requirements:

- ❑ A thorough knowledge of vertical turbine pumps.
- ❑ Working nights, weekends and/or holidays if necessary.
- ❑ Demonstrate ability to read and understand blue prints, equipment manuals and supervisory instructions.
- ❑ Ability to use a computer in plant operations and record keeping.
- ❑ Monitoring and working with and around hazardous treatment chemicals.
- ❑ Exercising the appropriate safety precautions in performing work functions that include, but not limited to: blood borne pathogens, spill prevention, chemical storage, personal protective equipment, and etc.
- ❑ Must be a resident of Shelby or an adjacent county or become a resident within one year from the date of hire. Maintain residency in Shelby or an adjacent county while employed with the City of Sidney is required.

Qualifications

- ❑ A high school diploma or GED equivalent.
- ❑ General working knowledge in mathematics and chemistry and/or supplemental courses in water treatment.
- ❑ A valid Ohio EPA Class I, or higher, Water Supply Certificate is required or ability to attain certificate in 24 months.
- ❑ Ability to achieve OEPA Wet Chemistry "Operational" lab certification within six months of hire.
- ❑ A valid Driver's License and a good driving record are both required. Both must be maintained throughout employment.
