No. 1 Georgia had to hang on to beat Kentucky 13-12 as 21.5-point favorites last Saturday night. Georgia has now won 42 consecutive regular season games but the Bulldogs fell to No. 2 in this week's AP poll behind Texas. Georgia plays at No. 4 Alabama next week.

Misleading Finals

Arizona State (+2.5) upset Texas State 31-28. However, Texas State had a 5.3-4.8 yards per play edge but were -2 in TO's and blew a 14-point lead.

UNLV (+9) upset Kansas 23-20. However, Kansas had a 6.0-4.1 yards per play edge but were -2 in TO's and blew an 11-point lead. UNLV scored on a TD on the last play of the first half.

Coastal Carolina (-17) beat Temple 28-20. However, Temple had a 314-287 yard edge. The Owls were -2 in TO's which included a "Pick 6" and Coastal got a 2-play 11-yard "drive" after another turnover.

Tennessee (-49) beat Kent State 71-0. Tennessee led 65-0 at halftime!

Akron (-14) beat Colgate 31-20. Akron trailed 17-0 at one point.

Charlotte (-14) beat Gardner-Webb 27-26. Charlotte trailed 20-3 in the 3Q.

Maryland (+3) beat Virginia 27-13. However, Virginia had a 5.5-4.9 yards per play edge but were -4 in TO's.

Bad Beats

South Alabama (-37) beat Northwestern State 87-10 on Thursday. The total in the game was 59. Many sports books have rules that football games must play at least 55 minutes for there to be action on your bets. The 4Q was shortened by 9 minutes leaving many South Alabama and OVER backers just getting their tickets voided instead of cashed. It was the most points scored by a FBS team in a game since 1990. The same held true for the **VMI at Georgia Tech game** on Saturday. Georgia Tech was 44.5-point favorite and the total was 54.5. Georgia Tech won 59-7 but both the third and fourth quarters were shortened. Many GT and OVER backers just got a refund.

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, September 19th

APPALACHIAN STATE 35 South Alabama 26. South Alabama comes in off the historic 87-10 win over a hapless Northwestern State team. It was the most points scored by any FBS team in any game in 34 years. App State has played the tougher schedule but has 2 days less rest. Our power ratings lean App St.

Friday, September 20th

SYRACUSE 33 Stanford 25. Both teams come in off a bye. We've been impressed with Syracuse QB Kyle McCord who has 735 yards passing and 8 TD's in two games. However, we do trust the more experienced head coach in Troy Taylor with extra time.

NEBRASKA 26 Illinois 17. Both teams are 3-0 and both are ranked in the AP Top 25. However, we only have Illinois No. 56 in our power ratings (Nebraska No. 26). Both teams defenses rank in the Top 15 in scoring but we trust Nebraska true frosh QB Dylan Raiola to make a few more plays on offense.

WASHINGTON STATE 34 San Jose State 21. San Jose State has played a weak schedule so far but kudos to new coach Ken Niumatalo getting this team to a 3-0 start. They are No. 27 in ypp margin while giving up just 3.5 yards per play on defense (No. 8). Washington State is also 3-0 and averaging 8.0 yards per play on offense (No. 8). The Cougars are off the big win over arch rival Washington and could be a little flat. We bet San Jose and OVER on the open but would pass now.

Saturday, September 21st

CINCINNATI 26 Houston 21. Houston has been better than expected despite a 1-2 start. The Cougars are +0.9 in ypp margin and +76 in ypp margin with both marks better than Cincinnati despite playing a tougher schedule (No. 18 vs No. 102). We're not surprised with the Houston money in the market early but are passing at the current numbers.

Virginia 29 COASTAL CAROLINA 26. Virginia has taken big money late in the week in each of the last two weeks flipping from short underdog to favorite vs Wake Forest and Maryland. They got the big comeback win over Wake but last week a -4 TO margin did them in vs Maryland. Meanwhile, Coastal had a tougher than expected game vs Temple. 3-0 Coastal should be fired up here but UVA is the better team.

PENN STATE 53 Kent State 3. Kent State is by far the worst team in the FBS level. They lost to an average FCS team in St. Francis two weeks ago and trailed Tennessee 65-0 at halftime last week. They are getting outgained by 369 ypg! Penn State is off a bye and can name the score. That usually means a cover for James Franklin who tends to know the point spread.

OHIO STATE 45 Marshall 6. Both teams come in off an early bye. Both have impressed so far with the Buckeyes ranking No. 1 on defense in yards per play, yards per game and points per game allowed while Marshall ranks No. 16 in yards per play allowed on defense. We don't see much value.

BOSTON COLLEGE 26 Michigan State 20. Both first-year coaches have impressed so far. Michigan State is 3-0 (though 1-2 ATS). The defense has allowed just 242 ypg (No. 15). Meanwhile, BC has faced the tougher schedule (No. 9 vs No. 125) and the Eagles are No. 28 in ypp margin (No. 28). We don't expect to see a lot of tempo here.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS 30 Buffalo 17. What could have been one of the biggest flat spots in CFB this season was lessened a little by last week's bye for NIU. The Huskies got their biggest win in school history as 28-point underdogs over Notre Dame prior. Still, head coach Hammock was doing the media tour during the bye and are facing a Buffalo team who looks buttoned up under first-year coach Lembo.

SOUTH CAROLINA 38 Akron 10. A week after hosting ESPN College Gameday and coming up short in the final minute vs LSU could have South Carolina flat here. QB LaNorris Sellers (ankle) says he will play after missing the second half last week. They're facing an Akron team that hung around Ohio State for a bit in the opener. However, the Zips had to rally from 17 down vs FCS Colgate last week.

INDIANA 39 Charlotte 12. They haven't played the toughest schedule (No. 181 including FCS) but the Hoosiers have looked great so far under first-year coach Cignetti. Indiana is No. 6 in the country in ypp margin, ypg margin and scoring margin and embarrassed UCLA last week. They're playing a Charlotte team down to their 3rd string QB. The 49ers were down to FCS Gardner-Webb 20-3 in the third quarter last week before rallying.

WEST VIRGINIA 30 Kansas 28. The season is on the line here for a pair of 1-2 teams that had high expectations. Kansas has been better in the stat department (No. 23 vs No. 99 in ypp margin) but QB Jalon Daniels has been turnover prone with 6 interceptions this season. We haven't bet side or total.

NORTH CAROLINA 31 James Madison 19. JMU comes in off a bye. Neither teams has played that tough of a schedule so we will get a good look here. NC has by far the best player on the field in RB Hampton who has 416 yards and the Tar Heels have gone run heavy with QB Harrell the last two weeks. Our ratings lean NC.

LOUISVILLE 35 Georgia Tech 24. Louisville has been dominant so far ranking No. 2 in yards per play margin (+5.5) but the Cardinals have only played two games and have the No. 200 SOS according to Sagarin. We do like the situation for them here coming off a bye vs a Georgia Tech team playing their 5th straight week already.

CLEMSON 34 NC State 14. QB Grayson McCall is out for NC State and CJ Bailey will get the start. We've seen the line go from Clemson -14 to -20.5. The Tigers are off a bye after destroying a solid Appalachian State team. They have revenge for losing to NC State last year.

Miami, FL 40 SOUTH FLORIDA 24. Miami had a school-record 750 yards and their biggest shutout win ever last week (62-0 vs Ball State). The Canes are +159 points so far this season, their best ever through the first 3 games of a season. They're facing a pesky USF team that is 2-1 and out-played Alabama for 50-plus minutes a couple weeks ago. We've seen some early money on USF in what is one of their biggest home games in school history.

Iowa 20 MINNESOTA 17. Prior to last year's controversial loss, Iowa had won 8 straight in the series. Don't look now but Iowa games are 3-0 to the OVER thanks to an improved Iowa offense that is averaging 419 ypg and 32.3 ppg. It will be tough sledding here vs a Minnesota defense that ranks No. 5 in the country in total defense and scoring. We made 50 bets on the openers but this game wasn't one of them.

FLORIDA STATE 24 California 21. Florida State is 0-3 on the season despite being a favorite in all 3 games. They're only the 5th team since 1990 to accomplish that horrific feat. Safe to say, we've downgraded them more than any team in the country so far mainly due to an offense that ranks No. 128. Now they face a 3-0 Cal team. We actually lean FSU but can't get to the window.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN 30 Ball State 24. Important game for both MAC teams to right the ship here. Ball State was embarrassed by Miami last week while CMU has suffered back-to-back 3-TD-plus losses. A ton of money on the OVER as Ball State's defense is much worse than last year.

KENTUCKY 33 Ohio 12. Will the real Kentucky please stand up? Is it the one that got destroyed 31-6 as a 9.5-point home favorite to South Carolina or the one that nearly upset Georgia last week as a 21.5-point underdog. We'll find out here vs an Ohio team that is a little better than we expected so far this season.

Utah State 30 TEMPLE 23. Both teams need a win. Both teams were competitive in games last week. Both teams are dealing with injuries to their QB's. We haven't gotten involved with the side or total. It seems like Temple would be the sharp side but we're passing.

ARMY 24 Rice 20. For the 2nd time in 3 games, Rice fell way short of expectations this time losing 33-7 to Houston as 4.5-point underdogs. Now they face a 2-0 Army team fresh off a bye. Rice hasn't played the option recently so it will be interesting to see how they defend it.

VIRGINIA TECH 27 Rutgers 21. Rutgers comes in off the bye after beating Howard and Akron. They're in the Top 20 in ypp, ypg and scoring margins but we'll get a better idea how good they are after this one. Meanwhile, VT has played the much tougher schedule (No. 75 vs No. 238). A sharp betting group likes Rutgers this week but we actually like the home favorite.

Fresno State 38 NEW MEXICO 24. New Mexico has one of the worst defenses in the country but QB Dampier and the offense are fun to watch. They have played a tough schedule so far (No. 13) but have been better than expected. Fresno destroyed New Mexico State last week but will have a tougher time here.

Kansas State 27 BYU 21. BYU has been the more impressive team in the stats +2.6 ypp margin vs Kansas State's +1.8). The Cougars defense has been much improved allowing just 3.8 ypp (No. 13) and 236 ypg (No. 13). Kansas State is coming off an impressive 31-7 win over Arizona. We originally liked Kansas State but have cooled on them.

COLORADO STATE 31 Ute 20. Colorado State head coach Jay Norvell is one of the most overrated coaches in the country. The Rams are 0-3 ATS and off a disappointing 28-9 loss to rival Colorado in front of a record crowd. They are facing a UTEP team that is 0-3 with a first-year coach. Both teams have really struggled on offense.

COLORADO 27 Baylor 25. Important game for both. While Colorado has the best player on the field in Travis Hunter, we think the Baylor defense is the best unit. With Aranda being the DC this year, Baylor's D ranks No. 12 and are a big reason they are 3-0 ATS on the season.

IOWA STATE 35 Arkansas State 14. We think Arkansas State is a fraudulent team. They are No. 126 in ypp margin and their final scores have been better than the box scores in all 3 games so far. They're facing an Iowa State team fresh off a bye. However, we're not find of laying a lot of points with Matt Campbell.

JACKSONVILLE STATE 32 Southern Miss 26. Jacksonville State is 0-3 straight up and 0-3 ATS and desperately need a win. Last week they lost in 2 OT's at Eastern Michigan. Southern Miss has been the better team statistically (+0.6 in ypp margin vs -0.9) but Jacksonville State has played the tougher schedule.

OREGON STATE 28 Purdue 23. Purdue comes in off their most lopsided loss in school history losing to rival Notre Dame 66-7 as 7-point home underdogs. Oregon State also got blown out at home to a rival in Oregon 49-14. Big swing game for the two teams seasons. We bet Purdue and OVER on the openers.

AUBURN 32 Arkansas 26. We trust Auburn in this game especially since they finally made the QB switch last week to Hank Brown who threw 4 TD passes and most importantly ZERO interceptions. Arkansas played brilliantly vs Oklahoma State two weeks ago but then found themselves in a dog fight to UAB last week.

OLE MISS 51 Georgia Southern 14. Ole Miss hasn't played anyone yet this season but give them credit for being super dominant at 3-0 ATS ranking No. 3 in ypp margin, No. 2 in ypp margin and No. 2 in scoring margin. Georgia Southern is also 3-0 ATS this season but their No. 129 defense will be severely over-matched here.

TCU 31 SMU 28. Iron Skillet with Sonny Dykes being a former SMU coach. SMU comes in off a bye after losing outright to BYU. The Mustangs are going with Kevin Jennings at QB. Meanwhile, TCU led UCF all game until the final minute in a tough 35-34 loss. Tough seeing either team meet preseason expectations without a win here.

Tennessee 31 OKLAHOMA 25. Tennessee head coach Heupel returns to where he was the QB of the 2000 National Championship team but was also fired as the Sooners OC in 2014. No team in the country has been more dominant so far than Tennessee who is 3-0 ATS. The Volunteers are No. 1 in ypp margin (+479!) and No. 1 in scoring margin (+59.4!!!). Meanwhile, Oklahoma's offense has ranked just No. 116 in yards per play. Oklahoma was favored by around a FG in this game all summer so there has been a big adjustment. Oklahoma has not been a home underdog since 2016 and hasn't been catching a TD at home since 1998.

TEXAS 53 UL-Monroe 6. The Arch Manning era begins in Austin and we thought the market over-reacted too much to Quinn Ewers being out. Manning is arguably more talented and there seems to be more energy in the stadium when he is on the field. It was noticeable in the spring game, vs Colorado State and last week vs UTSA. Texas is 3-0 ATS on the season (ULM 2-0).

WASHINGTON 26 Northwestern 16. Washington comes in off the upset loss to rival Washington State. Northwestern made a QB switch to Jack Lausch who went 20 of 31 for 227 yards and 2 TD's albeit vs lowly Eastern Illinois. It's going to be tough to get margin here for Washington as both teams run below average tempo and both teams have seen their games average 40 total ppg or less.

Tulane 29 UL-LAFAYETTE 26. How much will Tulane have left in the tank after full 60-minute efforts vs Kansas State and Oklahoma the last two weeks? The Green Wave have certainly played the tougher schedule (No. 5 vs No. 237) but ULL is fresh off a bye and have been pointing to this game.

OKLAHOMA STATE 27 Utah 26 . The winner of this game becomes the Big 12 favorite. Utah QB Cam Rising will play here after missing last week's game. We've seen the Utes go from 2.5-point underdogs to 2.5-point favorites. The Oklahoma State defense (No. 125) is the weakest unit on the field. However, Mike Gundy is 8-1 ATS and 8-1 straight up as a home underdog since 2016. Add another.

NORTH TEXAS 31 Wyoming 24. Wyoming has been brutal so far this season at 0-3 SU and 0-3 ATS and the offense is dead last at 3.3 yards per play. It's obvious they miss head coach Craig Bohl who retired last year. North Texas needs to bounce back after getting crushed by Texas Tech last week. Two contrasting styles but note Wyoming is playing at No. 32 in tempo this year.

TEXAS TECH 33 Arizona State 30. Arizona State has played the tougher schedule (No. 57 vs No. 116) and is better in ypp margin (+1.3 vs +0.5), ypp margin (+150.3 vs +77.4) and scoring margin (+17.0 vs +8.4). Normally, that screams best bet of the week on them. However, we're wondering if Texas Tech finally turned the corner in the blowout win over North Texas last week. We like OVER.

MISSOURI 38 Vanderbilt 16. Vanderbilt didn't pass the test of being a sizable road favorite for the first time in a decade last week. They lost outright to Georgia State and lost whatever momentum they had this season. Missouri is 3-0 and finally got tested last week in their come-from-behind win over Boston College. We think this week will be much easier.

Use 27 MICHIGAN 21. A match-up that was usually reserved for the Rose Bowl is now a conference meeting. USC's defense has been much improved through two games under new DC Lynn. They held up well vs LSU's OL in the opener and now face a Michigan offense that is switching to QB Alex Orji here after Davis Warren threw 3 INT's last week. We question Orji's passing ability especially with TE Loveland banged up. We also think Lincoln Riley will out-scheme DC Martindale. Our power ratings lean Michigan, our eye-test says USC.

LSU 42 UCLA 14. UCLA could be the worst Power 4 team in the country and we're not sure our power ratings or the market have a full handle on their ineptitude. The near upset loss to Hawaii has not aged well with Hawaii 0-2 ATS in their other two games and then the Bruins were destroyed as short home underdogs to Indiana last week. Yes, LSU is 0-3 ATS but kudos to them for the 17-point come-from-behind win last week at South Carolina that probably saved their season.

Florida 30 MISSISSIPPI STATE 24. Tough game to handicap. On one side, you have Florida head coach Billy Napier one loss away from being fired. On the other, you have a Mississippi State team that just lost to Toledo 41-17 and could be the worse non-Vandy SEC team in a generation. Lean UNDER.

NOTRE DAME 37 Miami, OH 10. Will the real Notre Dame please stand up? Is it the ND team that upset Texas A&M on the road and crushed Purdue 66-7 last week or is it the one that lost to Northern Illinois outright as 28-point favorites. Here we are again, playing another MAC team at home as 28-point favorites. Will history repeat itself? We like OVER.

TEXAS A&M 38 Bowling Green 13. BG comes in off a bye after nearly upsetting Penn State. They face a Texas A&M team that has won their last two games including going to Florida and handling business last week. We think QB Marcel Reed could be better than Weigman as Reed threw 2 TD passes and ran for 83 yards last week.

Memphis 31 NAVY 20. A really good spot here for Navy coming off a bye playing a Memphis team that is 3-0 SU and 3-0 ATS. The Tigers just got a big upset win over Florida State last week. However, that's why this line is 9.5 and not closer to 13.5. We also think Memphis is much better on defense this year allowing just 68 rush ypp.

LIBERTY 30 East Carolina 25. Liberty is 0-3 ATS failing to cover to cover by 12 ppg. Their performance vs New Mexico State where they almost lost outright was one of the worst this entire CFB season that no one is paying attention to. ECU has played the tougher schedule and has a bigger scoring margin than Liberty so far. If it weren't for ECU QB Jake Garcia and his nation-leading 8 INT's, we'd call for the outright upset here.

CONNECTICUT 26 Florida Atlantic 23. Connecticut has played the tougher schedule (No. 66 vs No. 99). Yet the Huskies have the better ypp margin (+0.6 vs -1.6), the better ypp margin (-23.0 vs -69.0) and the better scoring margin (-0.7 vs -1.7). FAU is off a misleading win over rival FIU where they were +5 in TO's. We gave out UConn as our first play of the week to VIP customers.

LOUISIANA TECH 30 Tulsa 28. Some early week money has come in on LT in this one as Tulsa opened -3 at Circa and now find themselves 3.5-point underdogs. We think the truth is somewhere in the middle. LT was impressive vs NC State last week but came up short while Tulsa under-achieved vs Oklahoma State.

Duke 32 MIDDLE TENNESSEE 17. Two first-year coaches with far different results to date. Duke is 3-0 SU under Manny Diaz. Meanwhile MTSU is 0-3 ATS under Derek Mason and are No. 125 in ypp margin, No. 128 in ypp margin and No. 130 in scoring margin. We like what we've seen from Duke's defense that is No. 11 in ypp allowed.

SAM HOUSTON 30 New Mexico State 16. Sam Houston has two impressive wins so far over Rice and Hawaii where they easily won and covered. Both of those schools are superior to this New Mexico State team that ranks No. 132 in ypp margin and No. 132 in ypp margin. Sam Houston has taken a lot of money in the market this week and we're a part of it. However, at the current numbers we pass.

Toledo 31 WESTERN KENTUCKY 30. Fun game here as Toledo comes in off the huge upset win over Mississippi State. Prior to that performance, the market didn't like Toledo. Meanwhile, WKU is going with QB Veltkamp here who was 27 of 30 for 398 yards and 5 TD's last week. We think he's an upgrade over TJ Finley.

Week 4 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

This year's record is 7-8 so far. Of the 3 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Oklahoma State +2.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is the first book in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). Last year we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Below is some of what we bet already. Starting last season, Fan Duel and Draft Kings have been releasing select CFB games a couple hours before Circa so those bets are included below as well.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, September 19th

N.Y. JETS 23 New England 16. Both teams are 1-1. We haven't been over-welcomed with either so far this season as both have a negative ypp margin. The Jets were +2 in TO's vs Tennessee last week and won despite getting outgained 300-265. Meanwhile the Pats fell in OT to Seattle and were -0.7 in yards per play. First home game for the Jets this year while the Pats have played back-to-back home games. We lean NYJ.

Sunday, September 22nd

L.A. Chargers 19 PITTSBURGH 17. Both teams are 2-0 straight up and 2-0 ATS and neither has played strong competition. We've been far more impressed with the Chargers who are +1.3 in ypp margin. Last week despite the market fading them, LAC crushed Carolina 26-3 with a 349-159 yard edge. Meanwhile Pittsburgh is -0.7 in ypp this season and were outgained by 44 yards and were -1.0 ypp in last week's win over Denver. Pittsburgh was +2 TO's giving them a +5 mark through two games (best in NFL). We don't think the Chargers will be as kind when it comes to turning it over for them. If you don't think coaching makes a difference look no further than the Chargers this year and the team Harbaugh left (Michigan). We love what he is building here.

INDIANAPOLIS 22 Chicago 20. You will hear us quote this trend a bunch this week but 0-2 teams when not facing another 0-2 team are 42-23-1 ATS (65%) in Week 3 the last 10 years. That says bet Indianapolis here. What also says bet Indianapolis is a +1.1 yards per play margin on the season compared to the Bears -1.5 ypp margin. Chicago got the fortunate win in week 1 over the Titans and were out-classed again by Houston last week. The Colts were -2 in TO's in last week's upset loss to the Packers. We like them to bounce back here.

Houston 24 MINNESOTA 23. Both teams are 2-0. Last week the Texans were a little more dominant than the final vs Chicago as they were +2 yards per play and outgained Chicago 310-205. Meanwhile, Minnesota upset the 49ers with a 7.5-6.0 ypp edge. Minnesota has been the more impressive team so far this season at +2.1 in ypp margin vs the Texans +0.6. However, more was expected of Houston prior to the season. A respected service gave out Houston -2 earlier this week but we would be interested in Minnesota if a +3 ever showed.

CLEVELAND 23 N.Y. Giants 17. The Giants are one of those 0-2 teams that fit the 65% trend (see Indy/Chicago write-up). The problem is the G-Men are -1.5 in ypp margin and haven't played an overly difficult schedule so far. Last week they were outgained 425-301 by Washington. The Browns got off the mat last week in a win over Jacksonville. They were -1.3 in yards per play. Not sure we trust either team.

NEW ORLEANS 25 Philadelphia 24. The Eagles come in off the shocking loss at home to the Falcons on MNF. While the coaches and offensive players get blamed for the failure to put Atlanta away, how about a Philly defense allowing Atlanta to go the length of the field to get a TD in the final minute? Obviously, you can make a case for New Orleans being the most impressive team so far off back-to-back blowout wins over Carolina and Dallas. The Saints are +2.4 in ypp margin while the Eagles are -1.4. However, the look-ahead line on this game was Philly -3.5 and now we are sitting at New Orleans -2.5. We think there is value on Philadelphia.

TAMPA BAY 23 Denver 17. An 0-2 team vs a 2-0 team that fits the 65% system. Denver was done in by TO's last week as they had a 295-251 yard edge vs the Steelers and were +1.0 in ypp but fell 13-6. Meanwhile, Tampa Bay is off the upset over Detroit where they were outgained 463-216 and were -1.0 in ypp but won 20-16 as 7.5-point underdogs. We're looking to bet Denver here but need +7 to become more widely available.

TENNESSEE 21 Green Bay 17. Tennessee has won the box scores in each of their first two games but are sitting at 0-2 on the season. Last week they out-gained the Jets 300-265 and were +0.3 in ypp but were -2 in TO's. The week prior they had a 244-148 yard edge vs the Bears but lost. Meanwhile, Green Bay was -0.7 in yards per play last week but upset Indianapolis thanks to a +2 TO margin. Again, we like the 0-2 team to get their first win.

LAS VEGAS 21 Carolina 17. Last week the Raiders pulled off the shocker (one of many in the NFL) as they beat the Ravens 26-23 as 9-point underdogs. Like many upsets, it was a bit fluky as the Raiders were outgained 383-260 and were -1.8 in yards per play. Carolina's 0-2 start has not been a fluke. They have deservedly been crushed in both games and are -2.2 in ypp. QB Bryce Young has been benched and Andy Dalton will get the start here. That has us leaning Carolina actually as Young looked over-matched. We prefer the UNDER though.

SEATTLE 23 Miami 17. We've seen a huge line adjustment here as Miami was -1 in the look-ahead lines and Seattle is now a 4.5-point favorite. Obviously, Miami starting QB Tua Tagovailoa is out and Skyler Thompson will get the start here for the Dolphins. Miami is 0-2 ATS and it looks like this could be a lost season for them. The Seahawks are 2-0 under the new staff but have played two of the bottom 5 teams in the NFL so far in Denver and New England. They catch another break facing a backup QB. If they win here and go to 3-0 we will be looking to fade them big time next week. As far as this game, we lean Seattle.

Detroit 27 ARIZONA 24. Detroit has not lived up to their lofty expectations so far this season. First, they almost lost to the Rams in the opener and then last week did get upset at home to Tampa Bay as 7.5-point favorites. The Lions did have a 463-216 yard edge. Meanwhile, Arizona is off a 41-10 win over the Rams as they had a dominant 7.9-4.7 ypp edge. We thought there would be value here on Detroit but need -2.5 to get involved.

Baltimore 26 DALLAS 24. Baltimore is 0-2 on the season despite a +0.5 ypp margin. Last week they got upset by the lowly Raiders as 9-point favorites. The Ravens had a 383-260 yard edge. 0-2 teams are 65% in Week 3 when not facing another 0-2 team so we will be backing the Ravens here. Meanwhile, the Cowboys are off a disastrous 44-19 loss at home to the Saints. There was nothing fluky about it as they were -2.4 in ypp. That's two straight blowout losses at home going back to last year's playoffs. We trust the Ravens staff way more than the Cowboys staff to right the ship.

San Francisco 24 L.A. Rams 18. The Rams are 0-2 and are -1.9 in yards per play. After nearly upsetting the Lions in Week 1, last week's 41-10 loss at Arizona was shocking as the Rams closed favorites at a few shops. Meanwhile, the 49ers were in a tough spot traveling on a short week to Minnesota and lost outright. They have won 9 of the last 11 meetings but we don't want to lay more than a TD here. We lean L.A.

Kansas City 26 ATLANTA 23. The 2-0 Chiefs come in off two straight last second thrilling wins over the Ravens and Bengals at home. They remain the kings of the Mountain until someone knocks them off their perch. They are just 0.2 in yards per play margin this season and were outgained last week. Meanwhile, Atlanta should be feeling good after that final minute TD drive to beat the Eagles on MNF. The Falcons are +1.1 in ypp and we lean with them here getting the hook.

Monday, September 23rd

BUFFALO 24 Jacksonville 20. We get two MNF games on the same family of networks around the same time. How does that make sense when you are trying to maximize profits around isolated TV events? Old man rant over. Anyways, we have the 0-2 Jaguars in desperation mode after a pair of close losses to the Dolphins and Browns. The Jags are +0.2 in yards per play margin but obviously the offense is struggling. Meanwhile, we have the 2-0 Bills with extra time to prep after crushing the Dolphins last Thursday night. Sorry to sound like a broken record but we like the 0-2 team.

CINCINNATI 28 Washington 20. Finally, we have the 0-2 desperate Cincinnati Bengals playing at home vs a rookie QB led Washington team. The Bengals are better than their record as they are +0.3 in yards per play. They out-gained the Chiefs last week but blew it late. Meanwhile, Washington should be "fat and happy" after getting a division win last week over the Giants. Washington is still -0.4 ypp on the season. Did we mention that 0-2 teams in Week 3 are 65% ATS the last 10 years?
