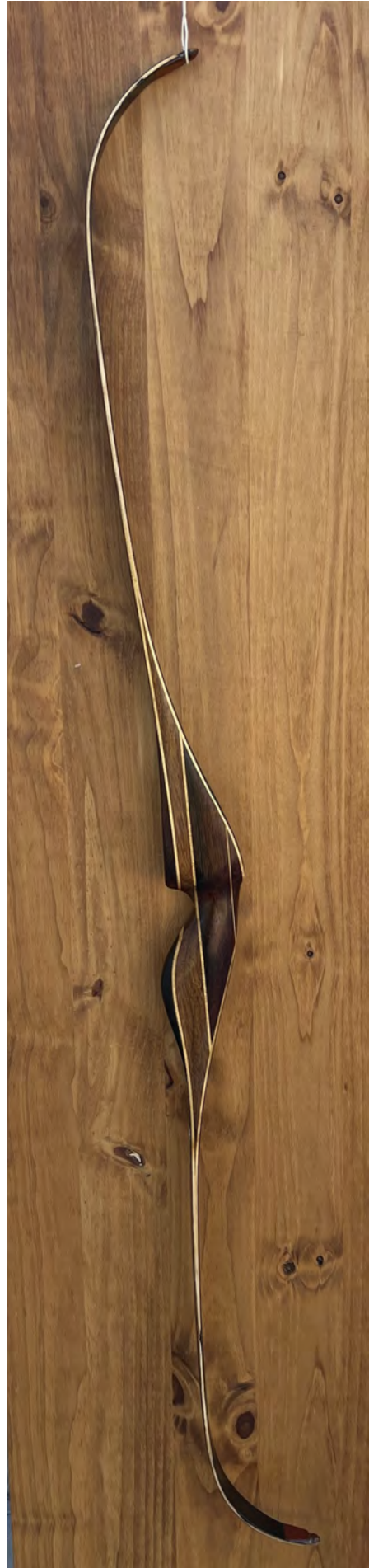

DESCRIPTION: The Cheetah Special was the top hunting bow of the American Archery line. It was a highly regarded bow. One this old is a hard find. This bow is an exceptional shooter. . Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in poor-fair condition. Dark brown webbed fiberglass limbs which do show some wear and tear. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition considering it is 62 years old. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot with amazingly tight groups. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a used string that is still in good condition. .

This bow sold for \$70 in 1963, which translates to \$721 in 2025 inflation adjusted dollars.
