



When ordering be sure to specify bow weight, length of draw, whether right or left handed and any other pertinent information.

When ordering arrows state bow weight and arrow length - see illustration. Where arrow length is different from draw length (distance to back of bow) state draw length also. Broadhead arrows should extend at least 1/2" beyond back of bow in order to clear forefinger of bow hand.



ARROW LENGTH DETERMINATION

SPIR-O-FLETCHING

What is it? What are its merits? Technically these questions should be answered at length, employing a bit of descriptive geometry and the theory of aerodynamics. But briefly, we may say this: SPIR-O-FLETCHING stands for true spiral fletching and is not to be confused with diagonal fletching, erroneously referred to as spiral fletching. The merits of SPIR-O-FLETCHING are these: arrows absolutely cannot "plane" in flight due to warp or broadhead misalignment; smaller and lower cropped feathers for the same guiding effect as other types of fletching; lower cropping means less fraying of feathers; uniform rotation of all arrows in flight; does not create greater "drag" than straight fletching.


LINE-O-SITE

"Moves the Target from Behind the Bow"

The LINE-O-SITE is unique in design and simplicity and incorporates all the features most desired in a bow sight: light weight, easy but positive friction adjustment, no rattle, easily attached, fits snugly to back of any bow, available in plain lens, prism lens or post type sights.

The most revolutionary feature of the LINE-O-SITE is the use of a one, two or three degree prism mounted in such a manner as to project the target image horizontally, thereby compensating for lack of perpendicularity between sight and arrow due to width of bow limb, or to compensate for an anchor position which is not vertically beneath the aiming eye. These conditions are manifest when the regular sight is set as close as possible to the side of the bow and the resulting shot hits to the right of the mark, in the case of a right hander, or vice versa for the left hander. The use of the specially mounted prism (a one degree prism usually is sufficient) corrects this condition and therein lies the derivative of the name LINE-O-SITE. When no problem of alignment is experienced, the plain lens or post type sight should be used according to preference. Four, eight and twelve degree prisms are also available for vertical projection when needed for the longer ranges.

To apply LINE-O-SITE, cement to back of bow just above handle as shown. For a secure bond roughen surface of bow with sandpaper and apply TUFF BOND or 3M WEATHERSTRIP cement to felt pad on Slide



Bar. Press firmly into position and allow ample time for cement to set. To increase friction of Sight Mount on Slide Bar, pinch tabs of Sight Mount slightly closed with pliers. To increase friction of Lens Frame for horizontal adjustment, remove Lens Frame from Sight Mount and increase bend of Tension Spring. In cases where the LINE-O-SITE is supplied without the Tension Spring simply increase the bend along center of Sight Mount. To use Post Sight, insert stem of sight through holes of Sight Mount. A bead headed pin may also be used in the same manner as the Post Sight if so desired.

NOTE: Prisms are available in 1, 2, 3 degree lenses, mounted to project the target image horizontally; 4, 8, 12 degree lenses for vertical projection.

In cases where both horizontal and vertical projection is desired, prism Sight Lens may be rotated to desired position by removing Lens Frame from Sight and lightly spreading the frame apart to relieve friction on lens.

PRISM SELECTION: Each degree of prism will move the sight approximately 1/4".
