Pastoral Reflection

The other day, I ended an OCIA session with this prayer. It was written by Thomas Merton (1915-1968), who was a Trappist monk from Gethsemane, Kentucky. Several at the meeting said they had never heard this prayer before, so I thought I would share it as it's a great reflection about our journey to God. Hope it helps in your preparation for the coming of the Lord.

"My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going. I do not see the road ahead of me. I cannot know for certain where it will end. Nor do I really know myself, and the fact that I think I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you. And I hope I have that desire in all that I am doing. I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire. And I know that if I do this, you will lead me by the right road, though I may know nothing about it. Therefore, I will trust you always though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death. I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and you will never leave me to face my perils alone."
