Wed 8 Nov 2017	<ul><li>Day 1</li><li>Ovulation occurs.</li></ul>	
Sat 11 Nov 2017	<ul> <li>Day 4</li> <li>First day of mating.</li> <li>Sperm travel searching for mature ripened eggs.</li> </ul>	
Wed 8 Nov 2017 – Tue 14 Nov 2017	<ul> <li>Week 1</li> <li>Ovulation and mating.</li> <li>Fertilization occurs.</li> <li>2 cell embryos are in the oviduct.</li> </ul>	
Wed 15 Nov 2017 – Tue 21 Nov 2017	<ul> <li>Week 2</li> <li>Embryos will be 4 cell at start of week and 64 cell by end of week.</li> <li>Embryos enter the uterus.</li> <li>Feeding small amounts of high protein supplements, such as eggs, lean muscle meats (not pork) or liver is a good practice.</li> </ul>	
Wed 22 Nov 2017 – Tue 28 Nov 2017	<ul> <li>Week 3</li> <li>Embryos implant along uterus wall.</li> <li>During the next two weeks important organs in the embryos will develop.</li> <li>Mama's nipples begin to turn pink and enlarge.</li> <li>Mama may lose appetite during this week.</li> <li>Morning sickness may occur.</li> </ul>	
Wed 29 Nov 2017 – Tue 5 Dec 2017	<ul> <li>Week 4</li> <li>Morning sickness should go away and appetite returns.</li> <li>Fetal development of eyes, spinal cord and faces takes shape.</li> <li>The fur on mama's belly and around the nipples thins.</li> </ul>	
Wed 6 Dec 2017 - Tue 12 Dec 2017	<ul> <li>Week 5</li> <li>Palpation of the abdomen may be able to detect pregnancy. Puppies will feel like small bumps in the abdomen.</li> <li>Pregnancy confirmation by ultrasound is possible 30 days after mating or blood test 35 days after.</li> <li>Development of toes, whisker buds, and claws.</li> <li>Eyes now close and gender can be determined.</li> <li>The puppies are now considered fully developed miniature dogs.</li> <li>Mama's abdomen may begin to enlarge. She may also gain weight particularly if she is going to birth more than 1-2 puppies.</li> </ul>	
Wed 13 Dec 2017 - Tue 19 Dec 2017	<ul> <li>Week 6</li> <li>During the last several weeks, mama's nutritional needs nearly double. Feed small meals several</li> </ul>	

	<ul><li>times a day.</li><li>Enlargement of mammary glands as nipples darken and enlarge.</li><li>Pregnancy blood test December 19.</li></ul>
Wed 20 Dec 2017 - Tue 26 Dec 2017	<ul> <li>Week 7</li> <li>Mama may shred papers, blankets or bedding in an attempt at "nest building" in the last weeks.</li> <li>During the last 2 weeks, mama may become irritable and should avoid contact with small children.</li> <li>Moderate exercise is the proper approach. Neither forced rest nor strenuous exercise is a good idea. Short periods of gentle play and short walks are good.</li> <li>You may feel the puppies moving now but amniotic fluid will make counting the number unlikely.</li> <li>Definite abdominal enlargement.</li> <li>Abdomen hair will start shedding.</li> </ul>
Wed 27 Dec 2017 - Tue 2 Jan 2018	<ul> <li>Week 8</li> <li>Mama begins to spend a lot more time self-grooming.</li> <li>Her breasts may become swollen as her milk forms.</li> <li>Nesting increases as she looks for a place to have her puppies</li> <li>The mama may not have as big an appetite during this period. Her abdomen can be crowded with puppies.</li> <li>Mama will spend most of the day stretched out to give puppies room to align for whelping.</li> <li>Puppy movements will be frequent and easy to feel.</li> <li>Set up whelping box and allow mama to explore it.</li> </ul>
Wed 3 Jan 2018 – Tue 9 Jan 2018	<ul> <li>Week 9</li> <li>Nipples and vulva should be gently cleaned with warm water, trim the hairs surrounding the nipples to allow easier access for the puppies to nurse.</li> <li>Start watching for mama's temperature to drop—temperature drop to below 100 degrees signals that whelping is imminent.</li> <li>She may also become restless and seek seclusion.</li> <li>Nesting and digging in blankets will increase 12-24 hours before the birth.</li> <li>Puppy count xray January 5.</li> </ul>
Tue 9 Jan 2018	<ul> <li>Expected Date of Whelp.</li> <li>Expected date of whelp. Average is 63 days from ovulation, but birth may take place from the 58th to the 68th day.</li> <li>Appetite will disappear as whelping approaches.</li> <li>May see a clear discharge from the vulva.</li> <li>At onset of labor may pace, dig, shiver, pant and/or vomit.</li> <li>First puppy usually will be delivered within 24 hours of the onset of labor.</li> </ul>
