Since 1972, the Pickaway Senior Center has served the seniors of our county by providing Home Delivered Meals, Congregate Meals, Transportation, Homemaking, and Adult Day Care as well as programing which supports physical and mental health and increases socialization and general wellbeing. Our mission is to be the place seniors learn, grow, get energized, and access resources to live independently with the best possible quality of life. We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and depend on support from Pickaway County and beyond.
