Town Clerk Report: Our Town website visits for March 2021 was 1632. The Towns total revenue for the month of March 2021 was \$1,099.00: \$795 for Zoning, \$189.00 for dogs, \$25.00 for DEC, \$70.00 for Registrar and \$20.00 for late fees. We had 18 dog renewals and 1 new dog license. To the general fund, \$947.38, Dogs were \$61.00, \$20.00 for late fees, \$1.38 for DEC, \$70.00 for registrar fees and \$795.00 for Zoning. We disbursed \$105.00 to Wyoming County, \$23.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs and \$23.62 to DEC. The Board discussed and resolved to order a new laptop for the Clerk, as it no longer will update to new system.
