

The Code of Conduct for the Union Vale Senior Center Club emphasizes respect for others, maintaining a safe environment, appropriate behavior, and responsible use of facilities, including: treating all members with courtesy, refraining from disruptive behavior, avoiding offensive language, respecting personal space, reporting any concerns to the Board of Directors, and adhering to all Union Vale Senior Center Club rules; essentially, promoting a positive and inclusive atmosphere for all Union Vale Senior Center Club members to enjoy activities and social interaction. This Code of Conduct establishes a consistent standard for the behavior of UVSCC members. It is the responsibility of each member to read and follow the Code of Conduct.

Respectful Conduct for UVSC Club Members:

- 1. Always treat other members with courtesy and kindness.
- 2. Avoid using abusive, threatening, or offensive language.
- 3. Respect personal space and boundaries.
- 4. Listen attentively to others and engage in positive conversations.
- 5. Refrain from bullying or taking unfair advantage of any member or person.
- 6. Conflict of Interest: A member shall avoid a personal situation having a potential for conflict with the Club, or which could tend to compromise member's first duty to further the purposes and policies of the Club, or appear to conflict with them.

Safe Environment:

- 1. Report any safety concerns or hazards to UVSC Board of Directors immediately.
- 2. Follow all safety guidelines and instructions provided by the Union Vale Senior Club.
- 3. Be mindful of your surroundings and avoid actions that could cause harm to yourself or others.
- 4. Do not engage in physical altercations or aggressive behavior.
- 5. Opposing points of view: A member will endeavor to foster harmonious relationships with other members by frank and good faith discussion in meetings, and, at all times be open minded, recognizing that expression of opposing views is often healthy to ultimate decisions.

Appropriate Behavior:

- 1. Maintain good personal hygiene.
- 2. Be considerate of others when using shared spaces and equipment.
- 3. Refrain from abuse, tampering or theft of another member's property.
- 4. Refrain from loud or disruptive behavior during meetings, activities and programs.
- 5. Acts of violence, disrespect for authority, un-sportsmanlike conduct, misuse or abuse of the facility or equipment, or use of foul language or gestures will not be tolerated.

Facility Care:

- 1. Treat the Union Vale Senior Center's property with respect.
- 2. Dispose of trash properly.
- 3. Report any damage to furniture or equipment to UVSC Board of Directors.
- 4. Attendance and use of the building only during established hours of operation, not exceeding closing time without prior authorization from the UVSCC BOD.

Communication and Concerns:

- 1. Address concerns or issues with UVSC Board of Directors in a respectful manner.
- 2. Report any instances of harassment or inappropriate behavior to the UVSC Board of Directors.
- 3. Any question of impropriety should be brought before and decided by the UVSC Board of Directors.
- Confidentiality: A member shall provide an atmosphere which allows for candid and frank discussion of personal views. Said member shall not divulge information deemed to be confidential.
- Pending litigation: To coordinate the Club's defense and approach to the case, a member shall
 avoid individual discussion with a litigant, potential litigant, or third parties concerning any
 pending or threatened litigation against the Club, and shall refer all inquiries to the President or
 Vice-President.
- If members do not follow this Code of Conduct, there will be consequences. Consequences for violating the UVSCC Code of Conduct, may include a warning, temporary suspension, or expulsion from the club. Unacceptable behavior includes foul language, inappropriate jokes, racial, verbal and sexual harassment.

Each member and director should use the Code of Conduct to evaluate his/her conduct in meeting his/her responsibilities to the Union Vale Senior Center Club, General Membership and Board of Directors.

By applying for membership or by being a member of the Union Vale Senior Center Club or accepting an office as part of the Board of Directors (BOD), you are agreeing to the Code of Conduct.
